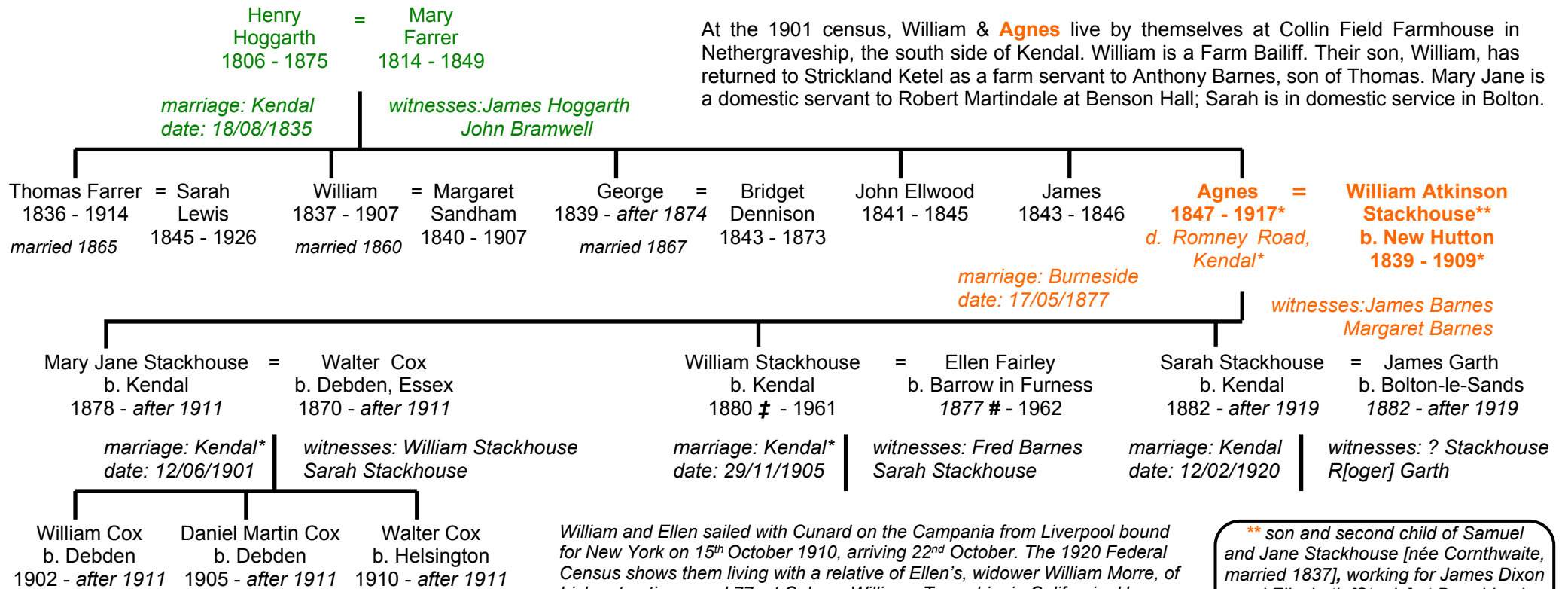
Henry's only daughter

Henry entrusted **Agnes**, after the death of her mother, to his eldest sister, Agnes, married to John Ellwood. The 3 yr old **Agnes** was thus living with her Uncle & Aunt in 1851 at Hollins in Strickland Ketel. *To avoid confusion with her aunt and two cousins (see below) she may have been known as Mary Agnes - Mary being her Mother's name - .Mary Agnes is recorded in the church register when her daughter Mary Jane was christened in 1878.*

By 1861 **Agnes**, and Henry's brother James' daughter, Agnes, (both named after their grandmother) are House Servants to Anthony and Margaret Barnes at Garnett House, Strickland Ketel. Margaret Barnes is their married cousin.

Uncle John & Aunt Agnes had another daughter also named Agnes and she married Anthony Barnes' brother, Thomas. In 1871 **Agnes** was back at the Hollins as Housekeeper to the ageing Uncle & Aunt. Two of the Barnes children are witnesses to her marriage to William Stackhouse.

At the 1901 census, William & **Agnes** live by themselves at Collin Field Farmhouse in Nethergraveship, the south side of Kendal. William is a Farm Bailiff. Their son, William, has returned to Strickland Ketel as a farm servant to Anthony Barnes, son of Thomas. Mary Jane is a domestic servant to Robert Martindale at Benson Hall; Sarah is in domestic service in Bolton.

William and Ellen sailed with Cunard on the Campania from Liverpool bound for New York on 15th October 1910, arriving 22nd October. The 1920 Federal Census shows them living with a relative of Ellen's, widower William Morre, of Irish extraction, aged 77, at Colusa, Williams Township, in California. Here they appear to have settled for the rest of their lives; they had no children. William worked in building construction. Both are listed in the California Death Index. William died at Colusa on 30th May 1961 [mother's maiden name: Hoggarth] and Ellen on 9th April 1962 [mother's maiden name: Massey]
