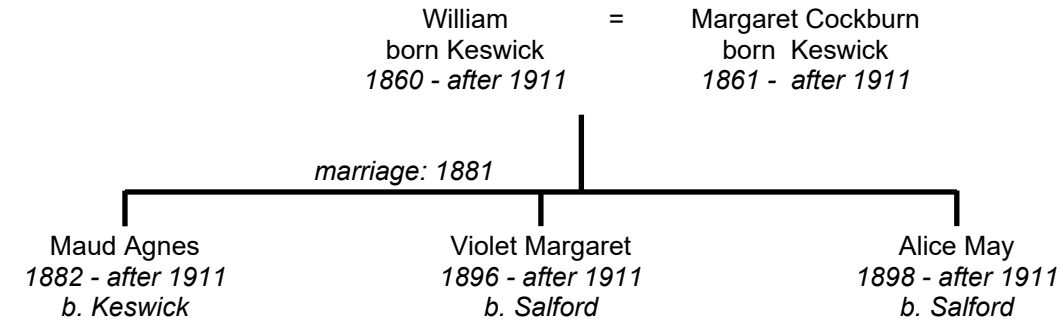
*In 1881 & 1891 the newly married Stephen is a pencil maker in Keswick
