**Obituary**

"Mr. John Steele, of Skelsmergh, died at the County Hospital, on Friday, from pneumonia. Deceased, who was eldest son of Mrs. Steele, of Must Hill, and the late Mr. Geo. Steele, was of a quiet disposition, and was well liked by all who knew him. Much sympathy will be felt with his widow and three young children. He was the oldest member of the church choir. The funeral on Tuesday was largely attended. The service was conducted by the Vicar and the Rev. G.E.P. Reade, of Ings. The choir chanted the 90<sup>th</sup> Psalm and sang the hymn "Peace, perfect peace."

This was a second marriage for both Thomas and Elizabeth. Thomas appears to have had at least four children by his first marriage: Elizabeth, Robert, Ann (parents at Jenkin Cragg, Scalthwaiteirigg when these three baptised) and Barbara.

Thomas's second wife is probably the Elizabeth Burton who married Joseph Graham in 1835. The 1861 census shows that there is at least one child, Ann Graham, from this marriage.

Thomas & Elizabeth are farming at Chamber House, Sedgewick in 1851, later to be farmed by William Farrer. Their later farm is Larkrigg in Helsington according to the 1861 & 1871 censuses. In 1851 Larkrigg was being farmed by James and Martha Simm who were witnesses to the marriage of William Hoggarth (1819 - 184?), nephew of Henry b.1806.

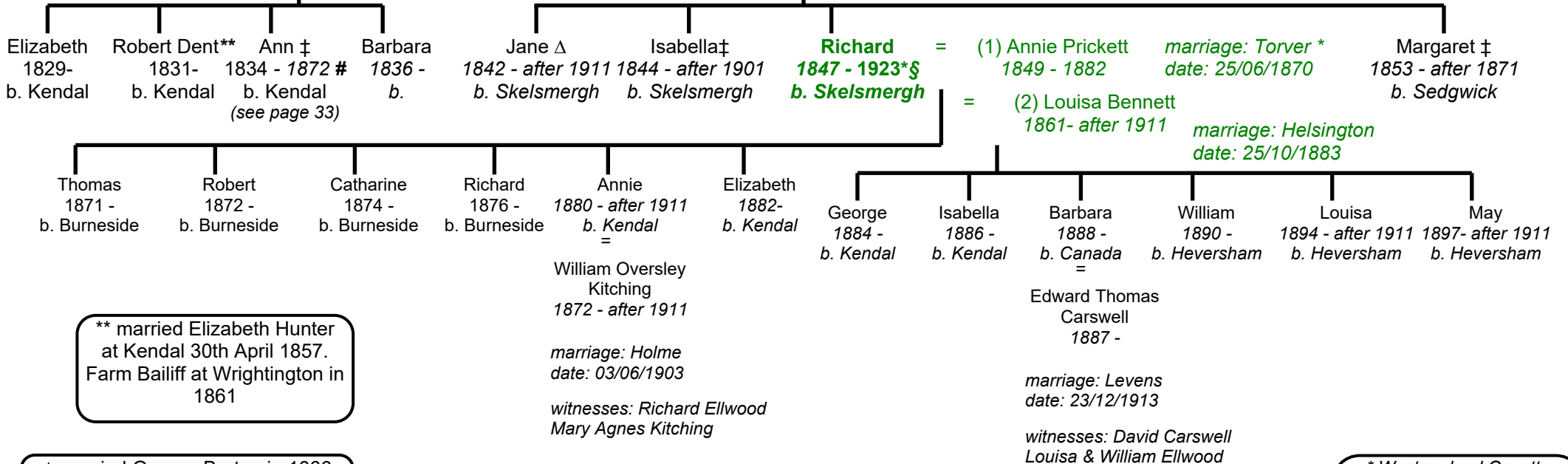

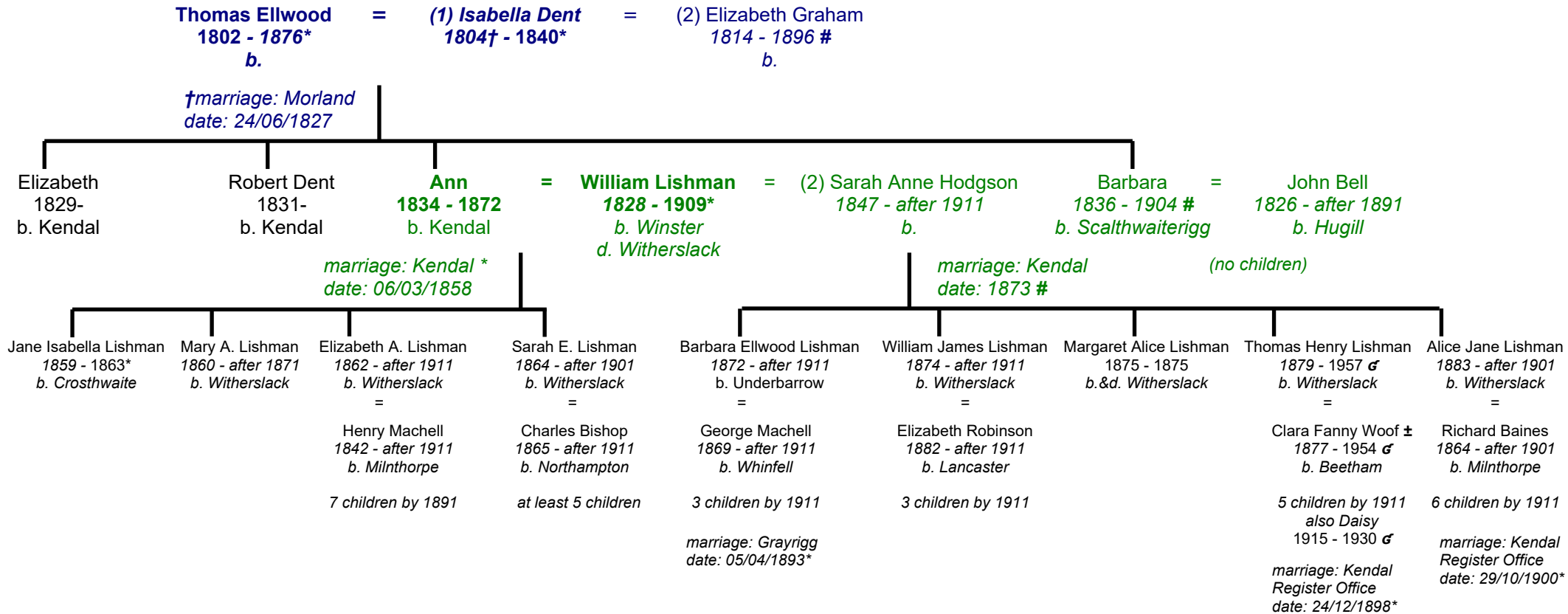
