Emigration to Australia

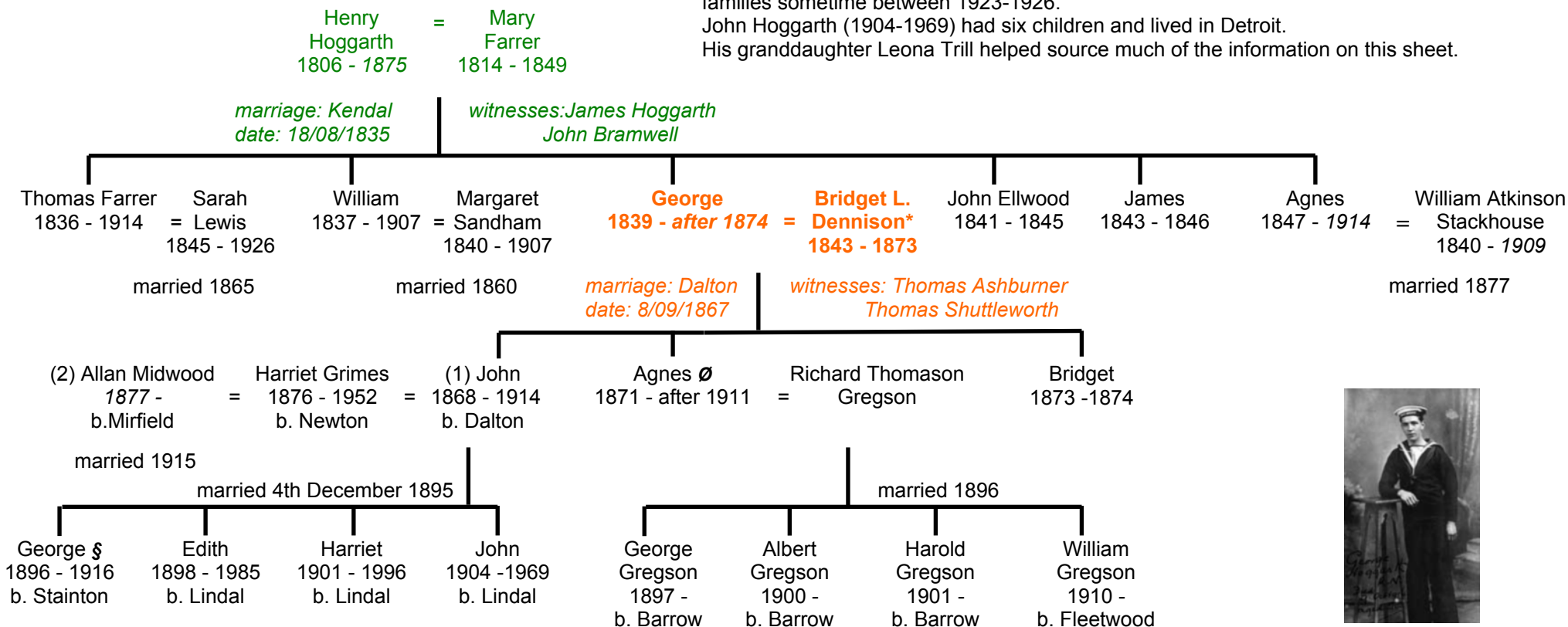
George followed William to work in the mines of Furness. He married a young widow in 1867. They lived in Dalton and the 1871 Census shows a son Thomas Dennison aged 5 by her first marriage. [Thomas, along with his uncle Thomas, is living with married aunt Elizabeth in 1881]

George is said to have emigrated to Australia after the death of his wife in childbirth. His children were left in the care of Thomas and Sarah and they were meant to join him once he had settled. In the event Sarah would not let them go.

The widowed Harriet Hoggarth married twice more and emigrated to the USA with her children and families sometime between 1923-1926.

John Hoggarth (1904-1969) had six children and lived in Detroit.
