

## Joseph Holmes born 1811

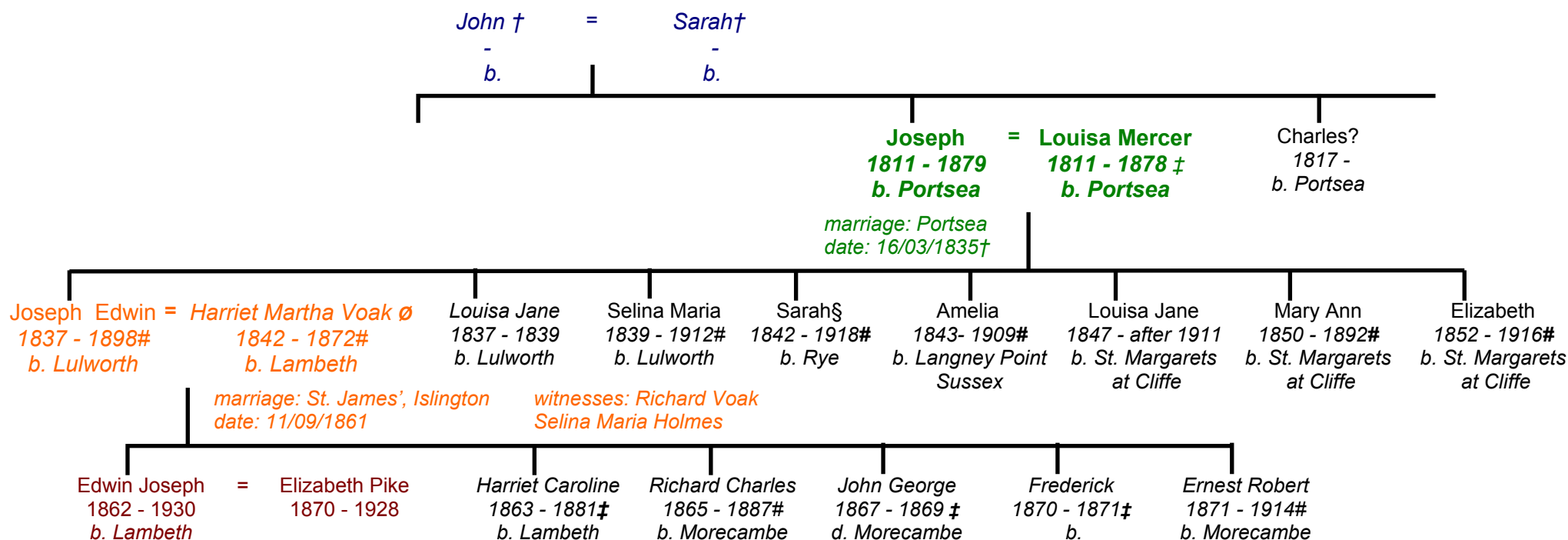

Joseph Holmes spent his working life in the coastguard service, moving from Dorset to Sussex, to Kent and then to Morecambe by 1860

Their only son Joseph Edwin was baptised at West Lulworth on 16<sup>th</sup> July 1837. His father's occupation is described as "preventive service". He had a sister Louisa Jane who was baptised on the same day.

In 1871 Joseph and Louisa are retired at Crest View Garden in Morecambe and he is described as "Naval Pensioner late coastguard". His son Joseph Edwin was also a "Marriner". It would be the son who is reputed to have been the captain of the Morecambe lightship.

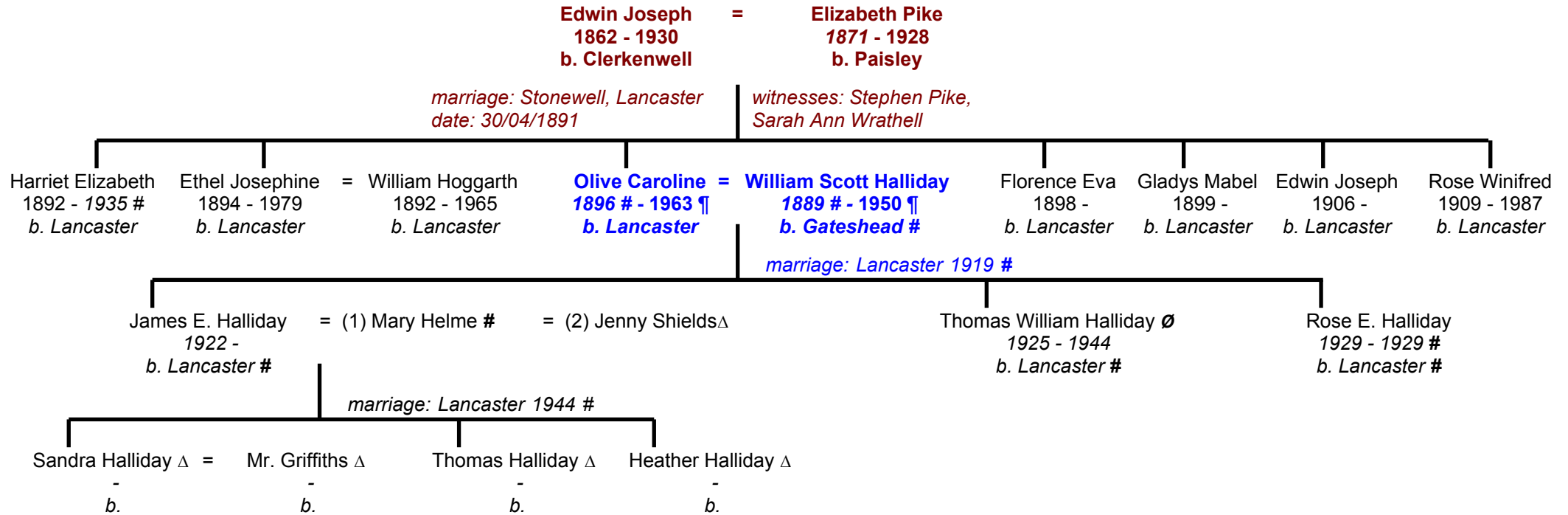
