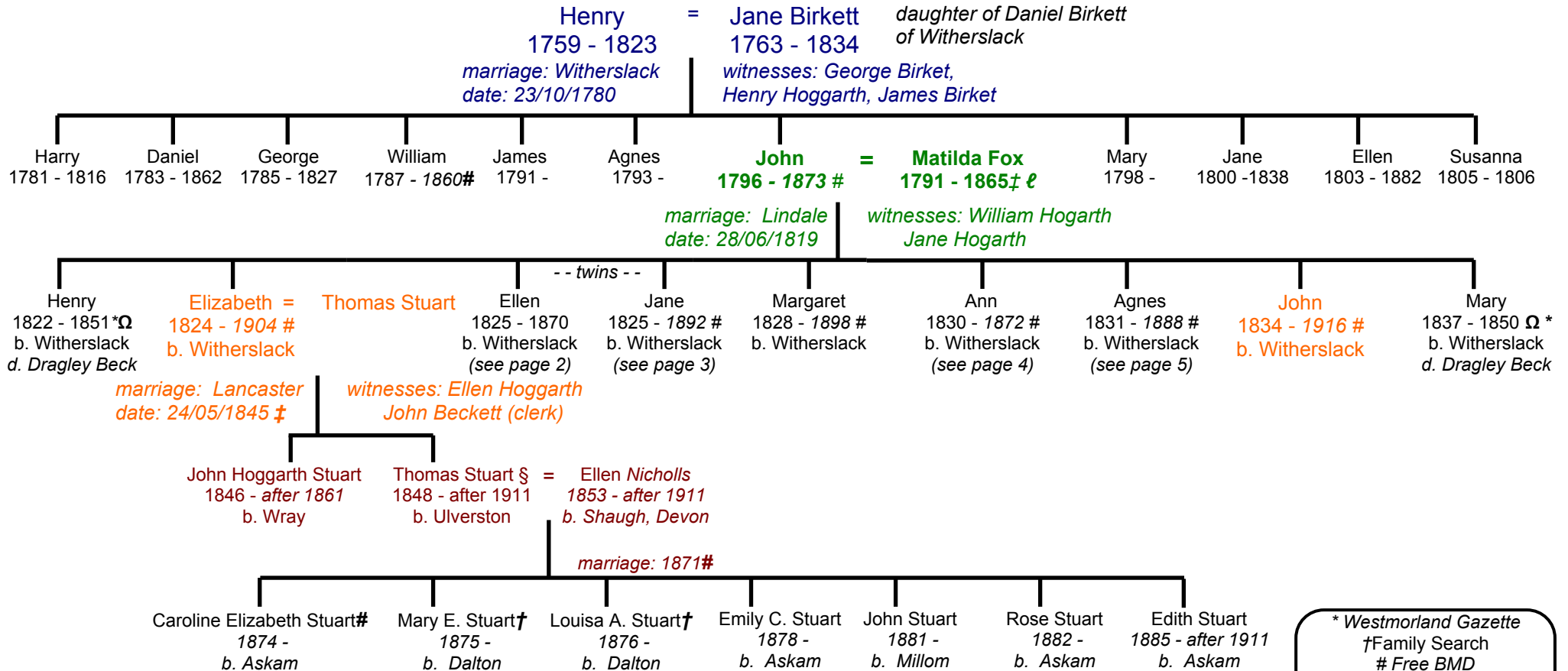


Hoggarth Family Tree

By the time of the 1841 census, John & Matilda had moved to Dragley Beck in Ulverston. In 1851 only Elizabeth and John were at home along with two Stuart grandchildren. Son Henry had recently died. Father & son along with widow Elizabeth were living in Urswick in 1871. By 1901 son John and widow and housekeeper Elizabeth were living at 43 Dale Street in Ulverston. The Johns appear to have been labourers all their working lives.

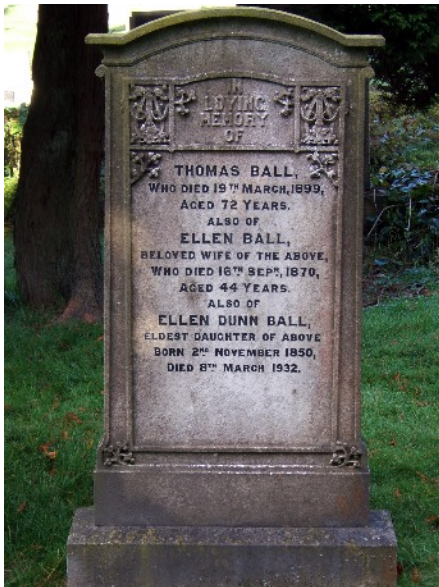
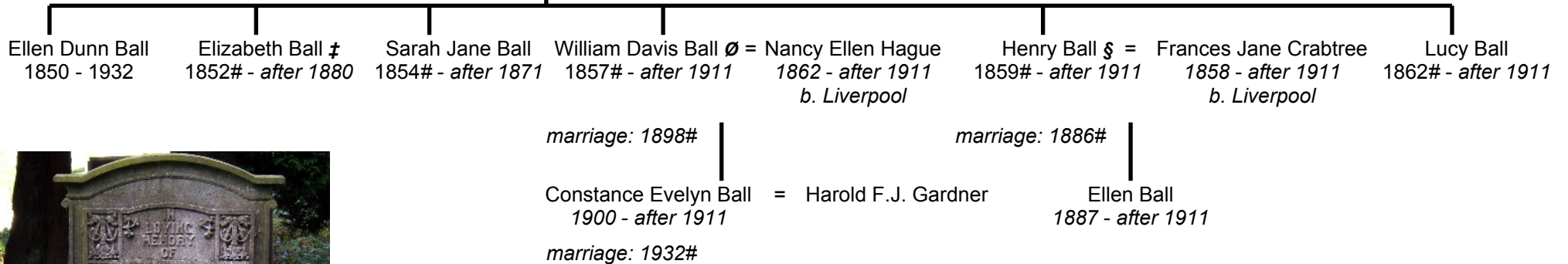
Ellen was born to John and Matilda Hoggarth in Witherslack, the same parish where her grandfather Henry Hoggarth (born 1759) married Jane Birkett in 1780.

Ellen had a twin sister, Jane. In 1841 Ellen's parents and brothers and sisters had moved to live in Dragley Beck Ulverston. She however was a servant to the Kitson family in Lancaster. By 1851 her sister Jane had also come to Lancaster for she was a maid to the Housman family in Skerton. Ellen was newly married to Thomas Ball who was originally from Leek in Staffs and a draper. They were living in Leonardgate, as they also were in 1861. By this time Thomas was a book keeper.

The Lancaster Gazette of 17th September 1870 announced that Ellen had died after a protracted illness.

At the time of the 1871 census Ellen's sister, Margaret, was living with the family of the recently widowed Thomas still at 16 Leonardgate, and was with them in 1881 as well. Thomas was now a ship broker, as he was twenty years later in 1891 at which time he lived with three of his children in Lindow Square. Thomas was on the Board of Guardians of the Lancaster Union. It appears that ever since the death of her mother Ellen Dunn filled the role of family housekeeper.

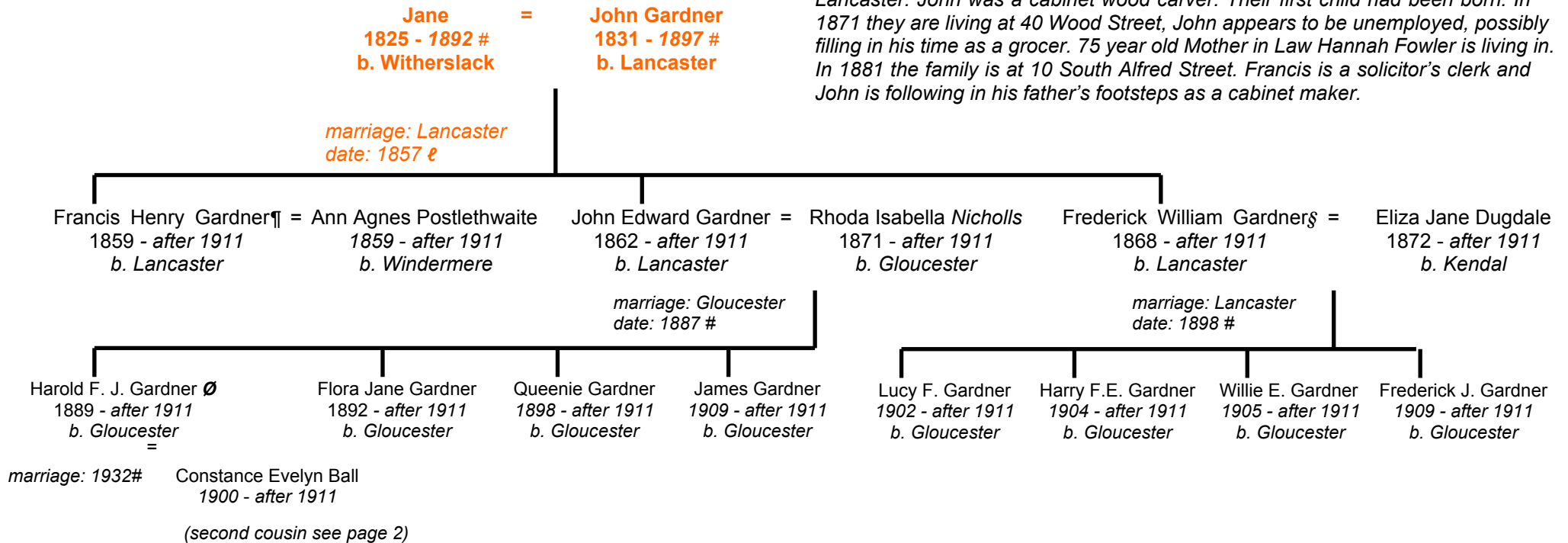

Jane married John Gardner in 1857. In 1861 they were living at 16 Lodge Street , Lancaster. John was a cabinet wood carver. Their first child had been born. In 1871 they are living at 40 Wood Street, John appears to be unemployed, possibly filling in his time as a grocer. 75 year old Mother in Law Hannah Fowler is living in. In 1881 the family is at 10 South Alfred Street. Francis is a solicitor's clerk and John is following in his father's footsteps as a cabinet maker.

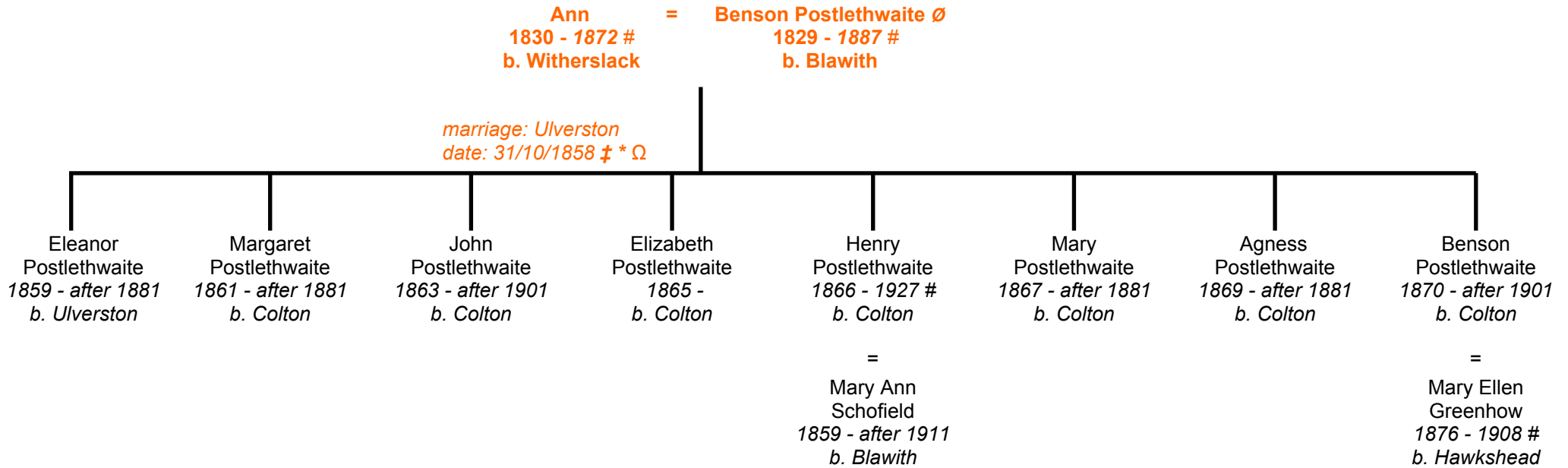

At the time of their Marriage Benson is an ostler at the King's Arms in Ulverston. In 1861 he is a farmer of 50 acres in Colton. Their son Benson married in 1899 and had four children. Widowed, he is the keeper of the Red Lion, Hawkshead, in 1911. Later in the year he marries his manageress Maggie Harrison from Burton in Lonsdale. His elder brother, Henry, is a timber feller in Blawith and has three children.



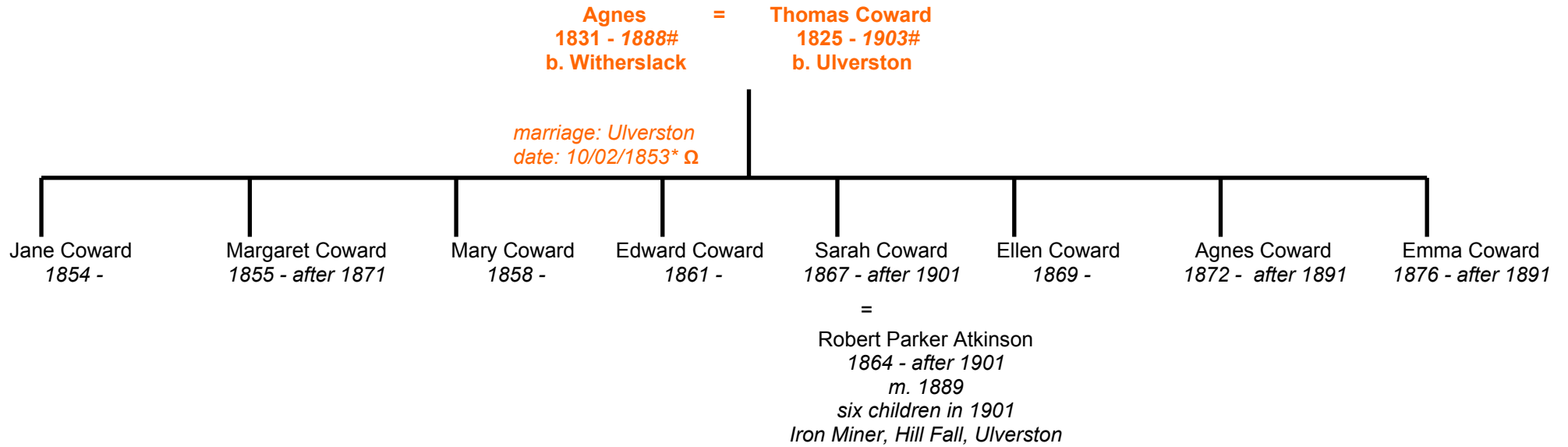
\emptyset son of John and Eleanor, baptised at St. John, Blawith in September 1829. He had a twin brother, Daniel, who died before the year was out.
