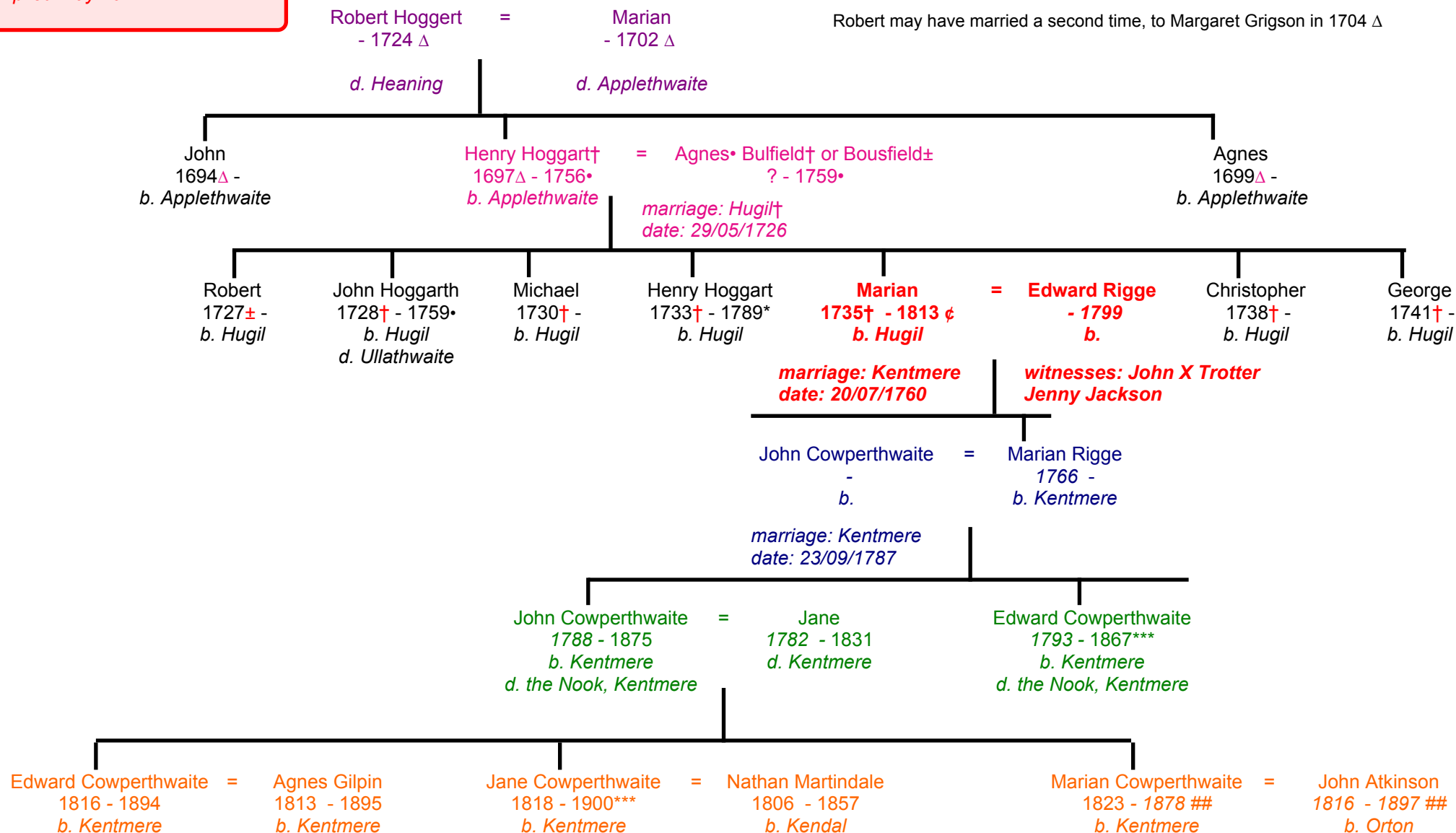


Marian Hoggarth born 1735

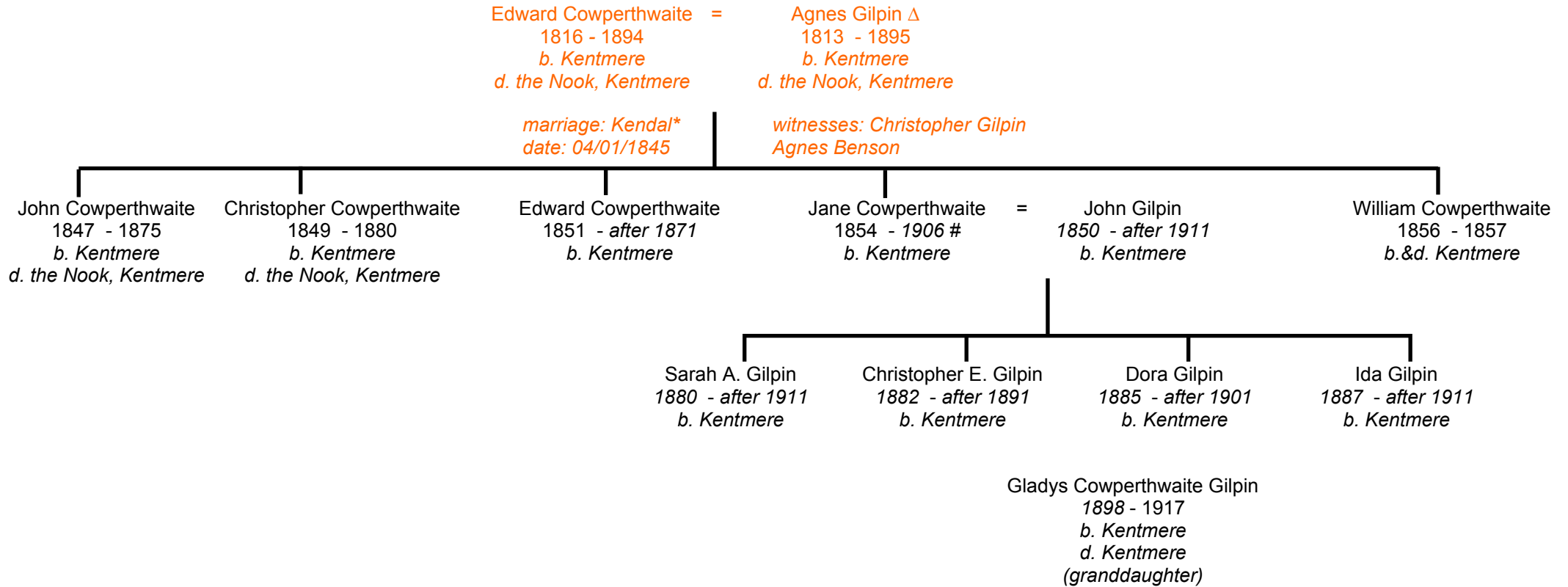

Δ daughter of Christopher Gilpin and Isabella (née Thompson) married 1803 at Kendal

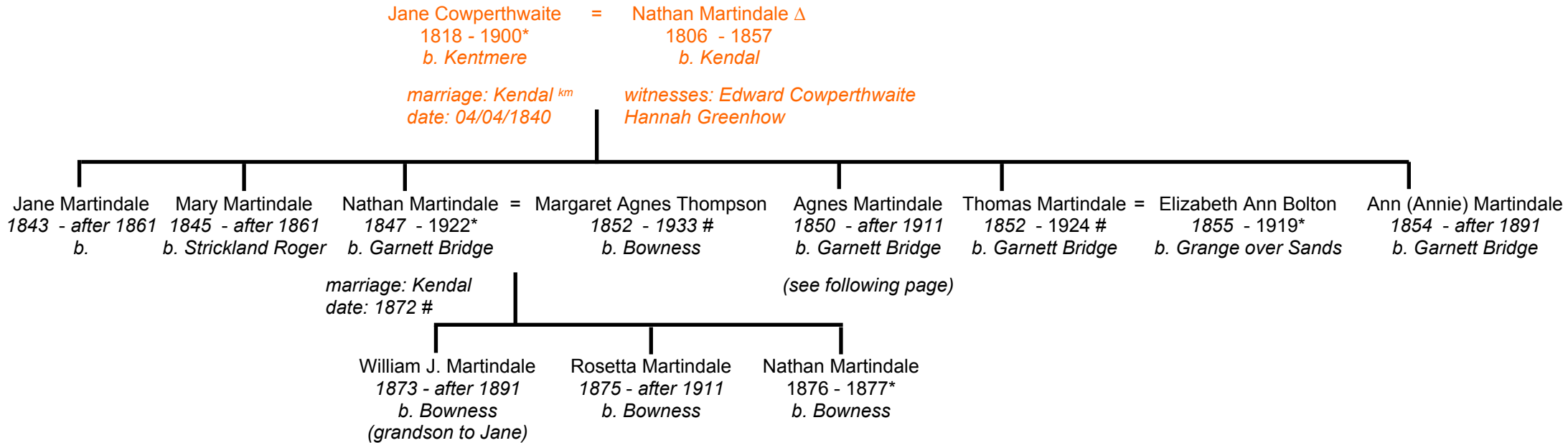

Nathan appears to have separated from his wife as Margaret Agnes, along with her daughter Rosetta, is living with her widowed mother in 1881, 1891, & 1901. In 1911 Nathan is a gardener and living with his widowed sister, Agnes Airey, at Millerground, where he dies in 1922.

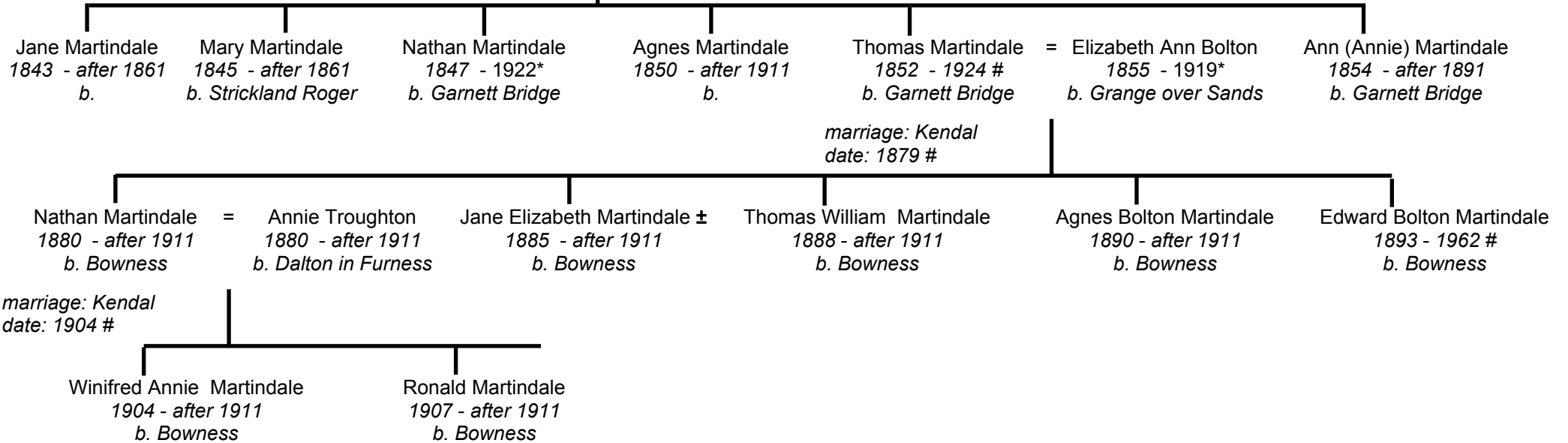

In 1911 Thomas is a master joiner in Bowness, living at 10 North Terrace, and his youngest son,
Edward, is a gas company clerk. There were five surviving children of six. The recently married Nathan
is still a boat builder and living at 2 Biskey Howe Gardens.

1861 & 1871 John is farming at Frosthole in Over Staveley

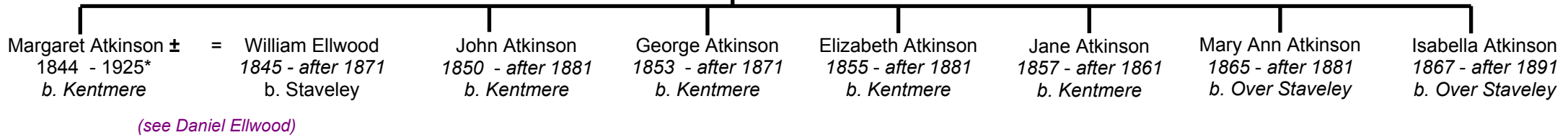
1881 The widowed John is farming at Nether House, Longsleddale.
