






Catherine High 1865 - after 1881 b. Urswick

In 1881 James & Margaret are living in Titchfield, Fareham, where James is an Ironworks manager. Two children are at home along with granddaughter Catherine Margaret Kent.

By 1891 James has married again but living back in Egton cum Newland as an iron furnace manager, there is one step-daughter.

In 1901 the couple are back in Warsash, Hampshire


