 across Morecambe Bay. In later life he delivered uniforms to  
 larger houses.

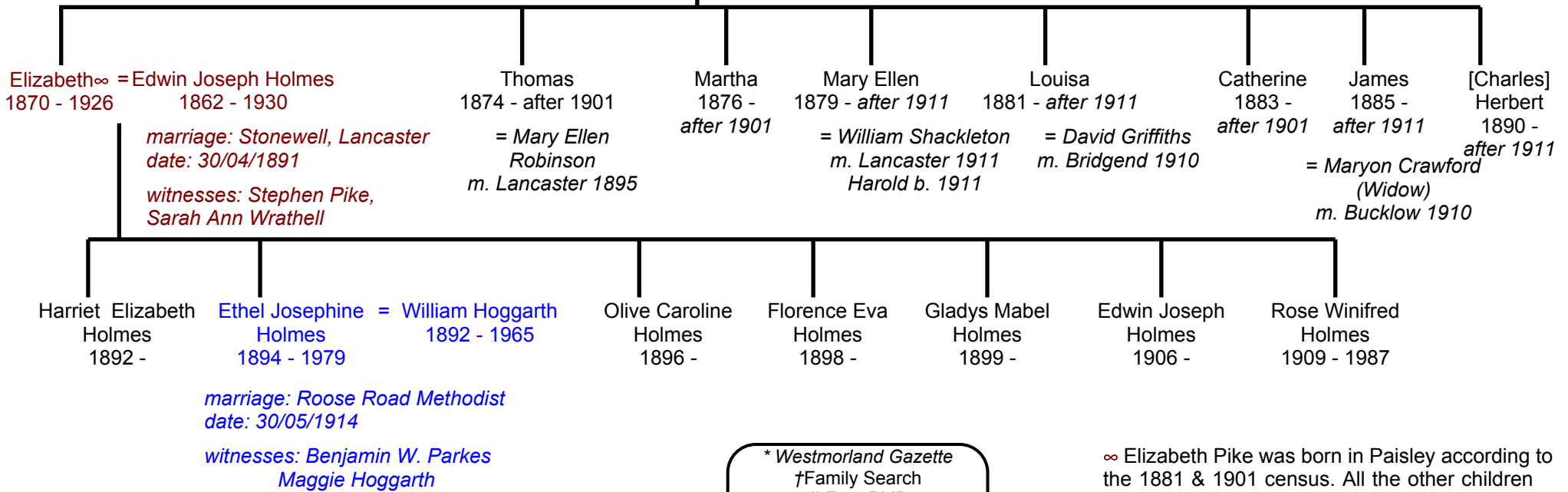
Hannah pre-deceased Stephen Pike. Stephen then lived with
