A Bernard and Betty Harrison (witness to the marriage of John & Mary?) had a child baptised on the same day.

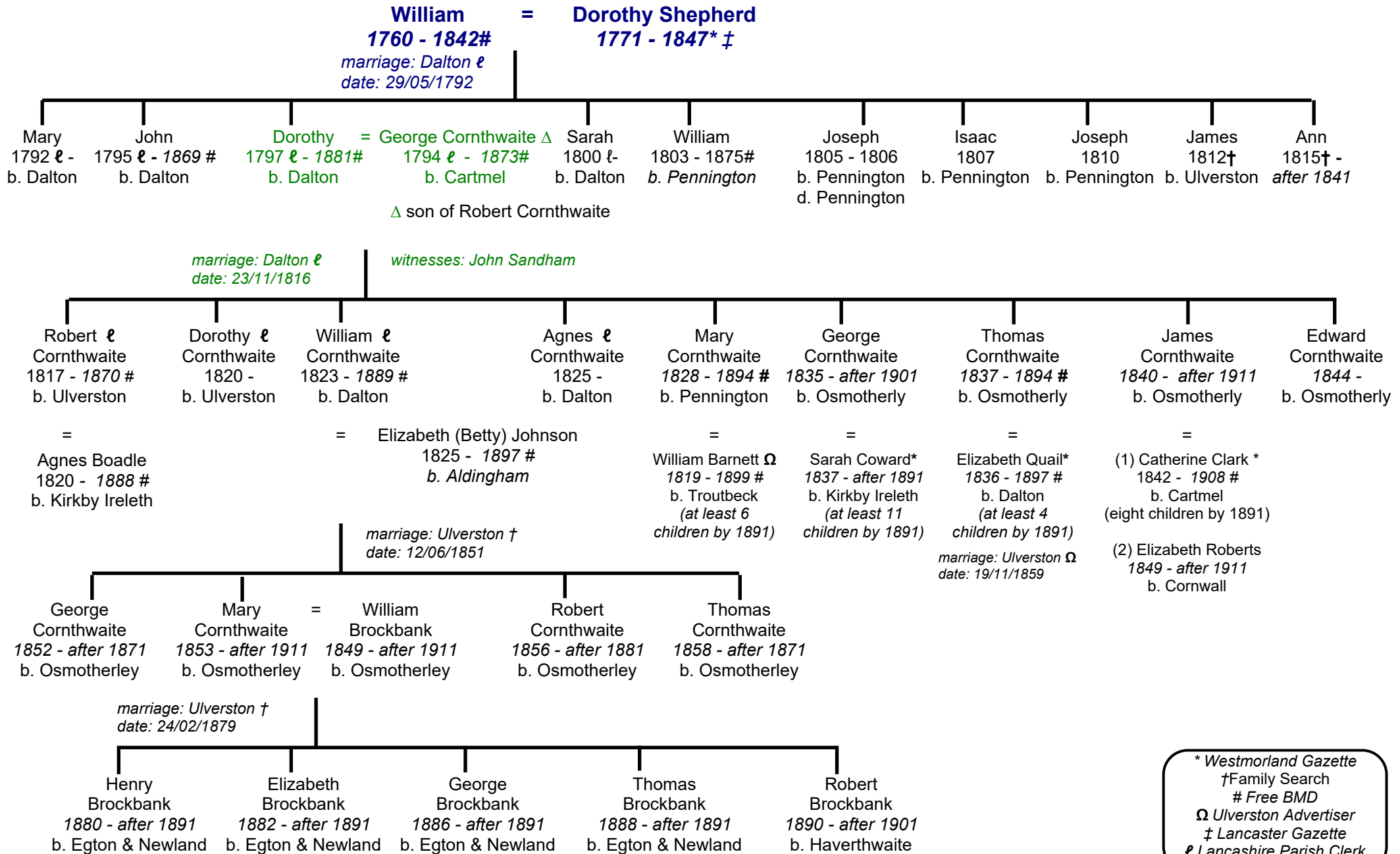

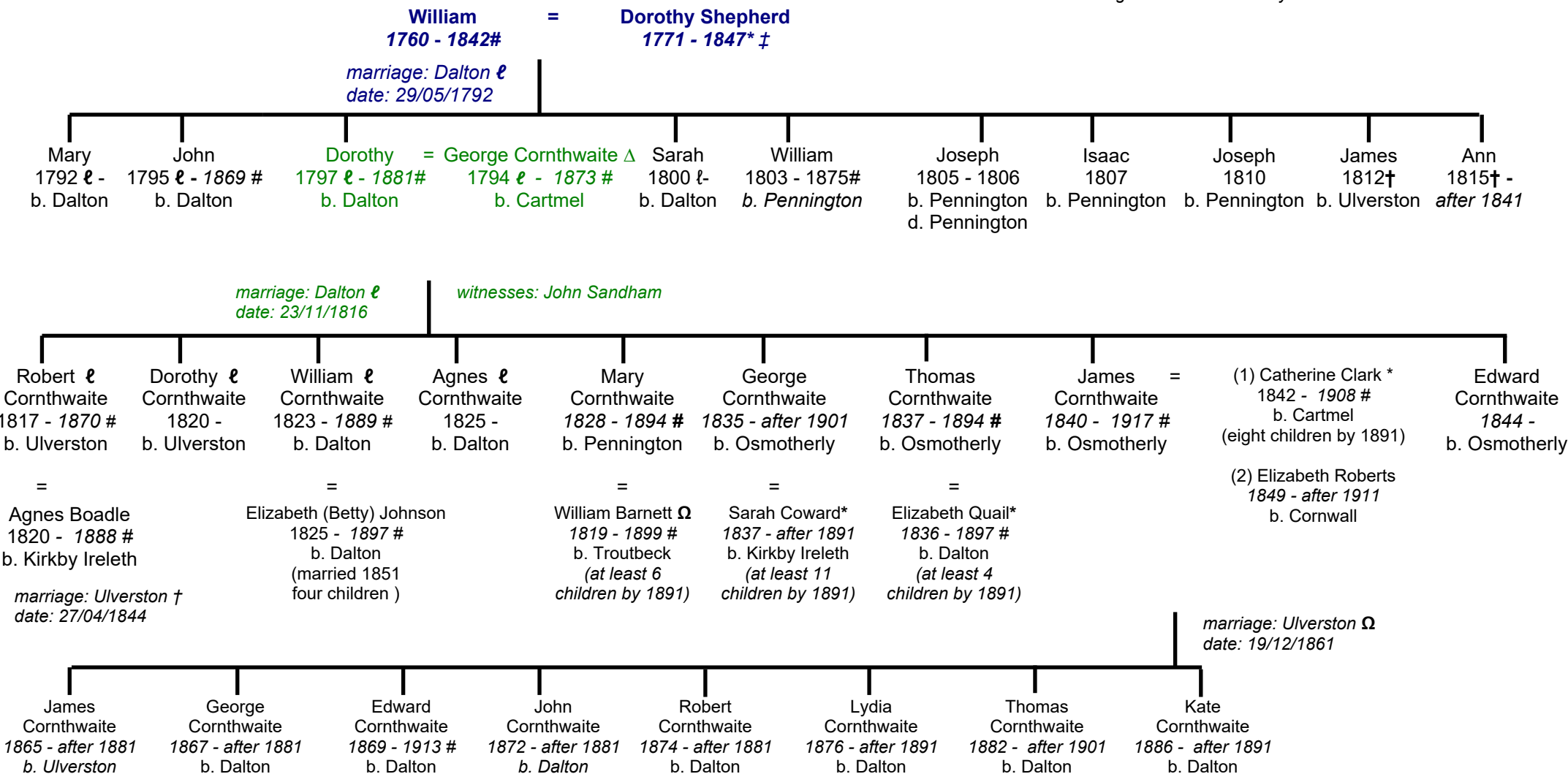

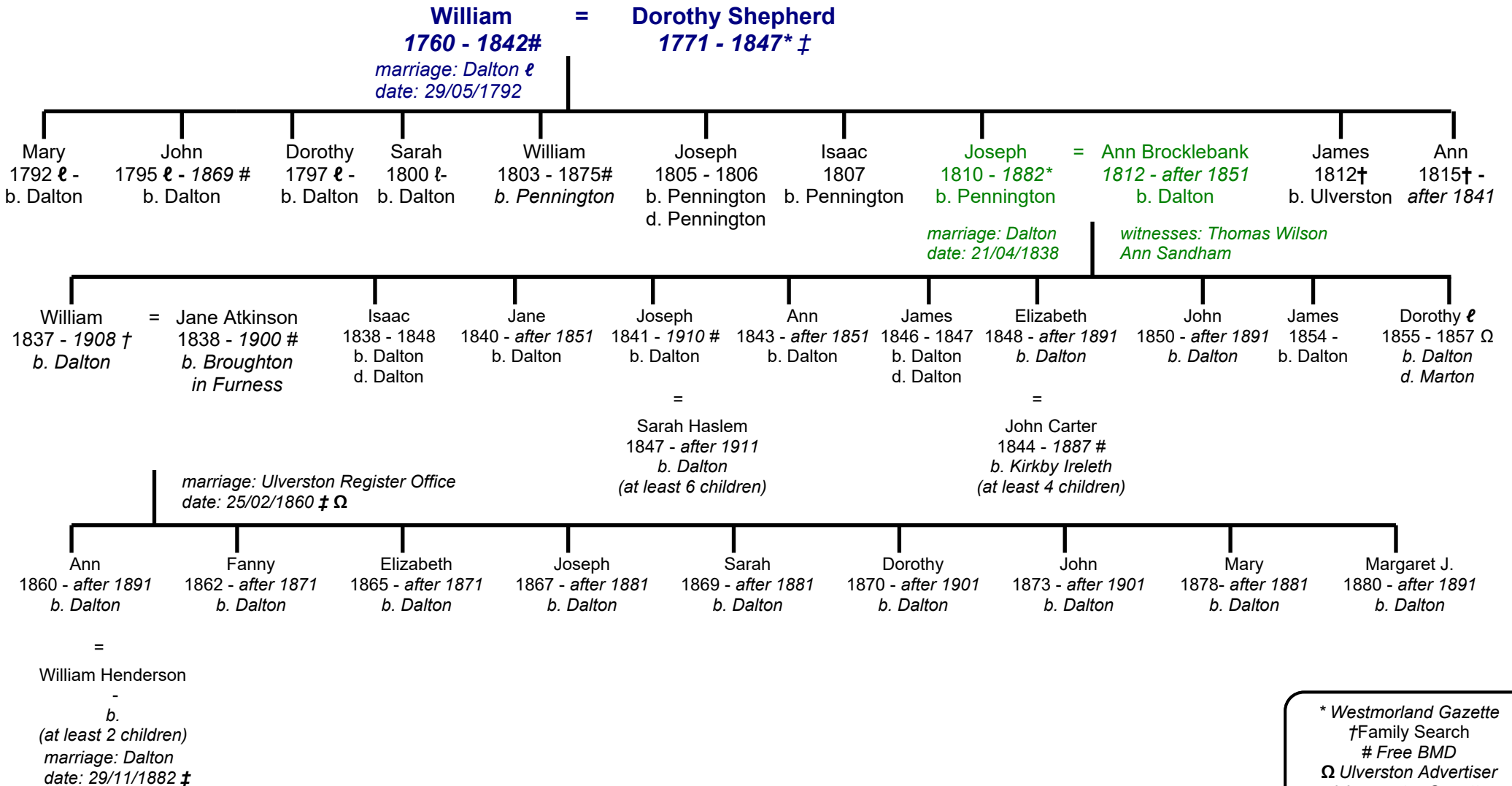

*Bigger would have been a hamlet towards the south end of Walney**Ormsgill would have been a hamlet near to the coast opposite the north end of Walney**Northscale was a hamlet towards the north end of Walney**Loppergarth (Pennington) is midway between Lindal and Ulverston**Hastygill is west of Ulverston possibly close to Rosshhead. Levy Beck flowed through it (which lower down becomes Dragley Beck)**Rosshhead Nook is about a mile west of Ulverston in the same vicinity, if not the same as, Hastygill**Tyteup Farmhouse is about a mile to the west of Lindal**Highgreaves lies between Rosshhead and Pennington (Loppergarth)**Whinfield is a short distance from Lindal towards Pennington**Lowfield House lay in Green Lane between Swarthmoor and Lindal**Tarnflatt is at Marton between Lindal and Ireleth. It is interesting to note that Robert Graves ( son of Robert Graves & Marion Hoggarth ) and his wife Catherine were living here in 1829.*
