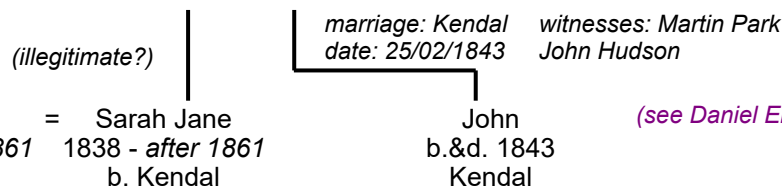
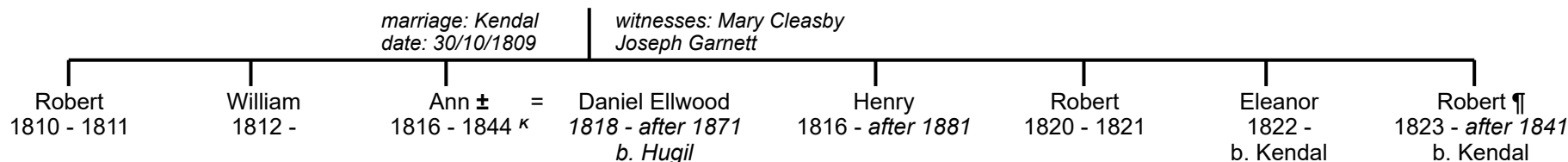

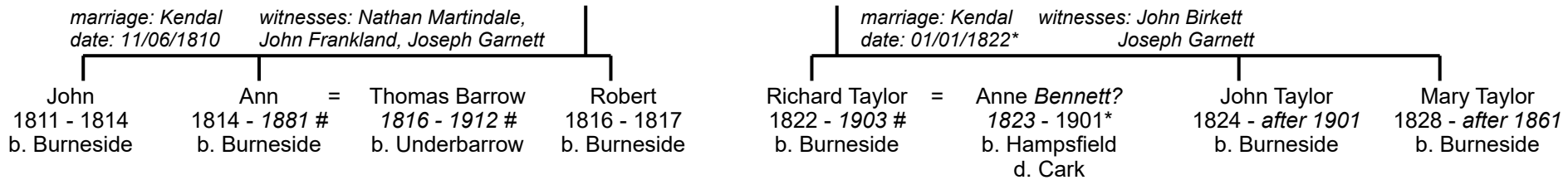
"On Thursday last, on the Beast Banks, of an inflammation of the bowels, Ann, wife of Daniel Ellwood, labourer, and eldest daughter of the late Mr. Henry Hoggarth, formerly of the Fox and Goose Inn, in the 29th year of her age. She was taken ill the day previous to her death, and on the visitation of the surgeon, was pronounced to be in great danger, upon which she immediately desired scriptural consolation, and the Rev. J.W. Barnes, M.A., vicar, attended her with such alacrity, as to leave two gentlemen who were waiting to prove a will. Another Reverend gentleman had been previously applied to, but it was out of his district, though within a stone-throw of the dying woman! Where was "outward reverence"? [Daniel married a second time]

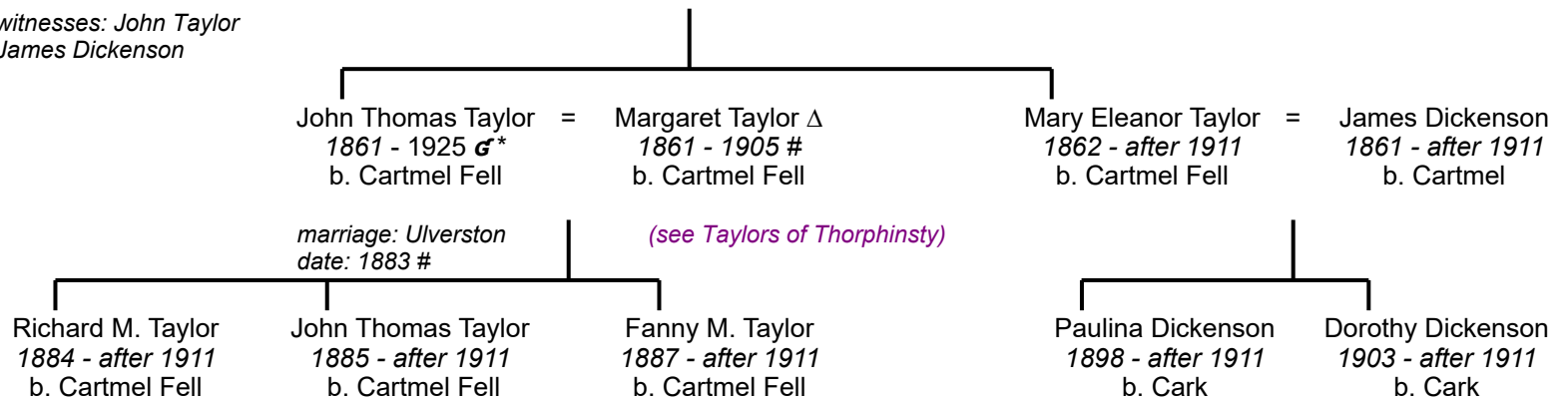
In 1851 the second time widow Mary Taylor is living with her three children at the Anglers Arms, Burneside where she died in 1869, having been the landlady for fifty years.

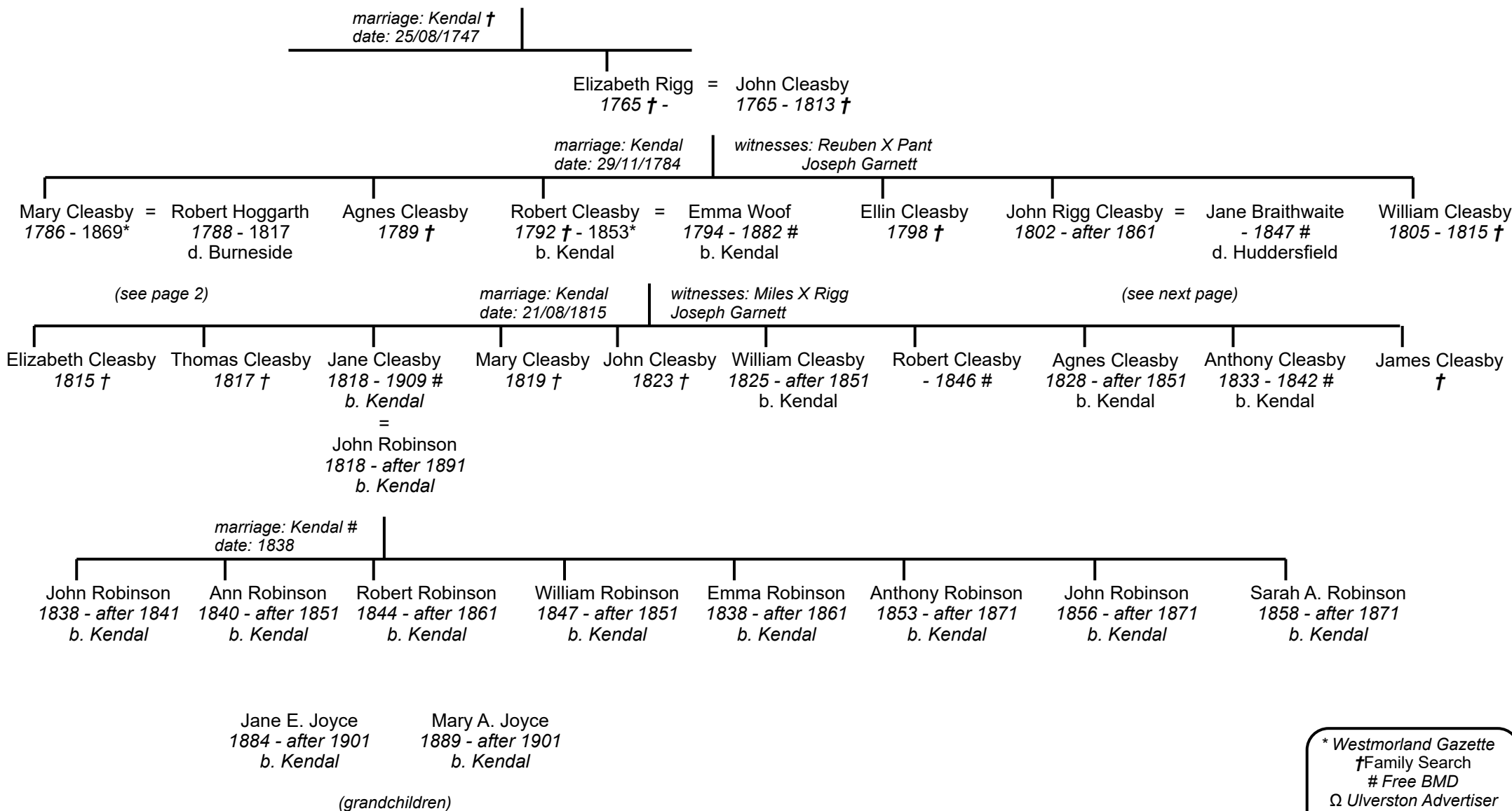
