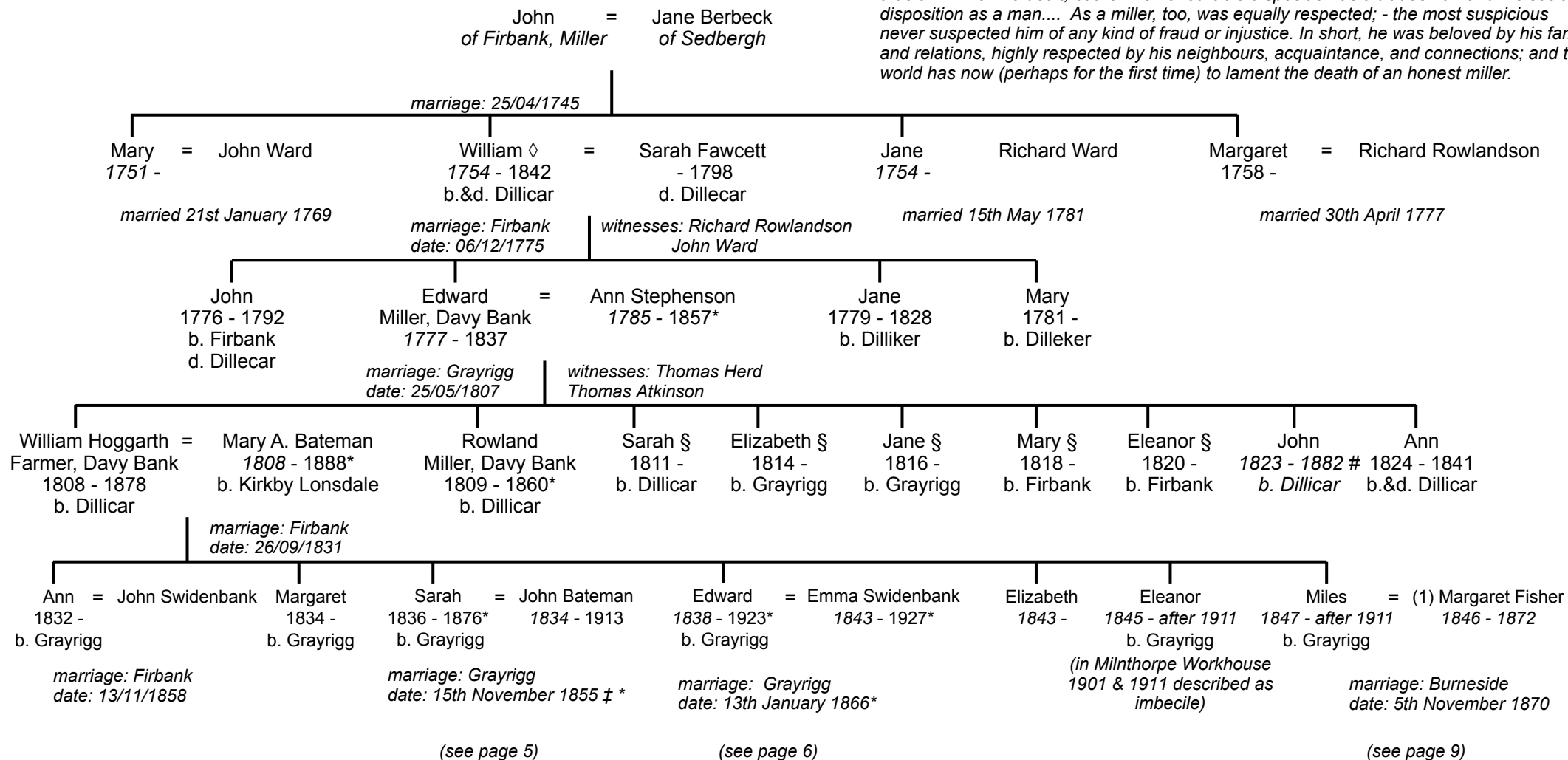

◇ *Manchester Courier and Lancashire General Advertiser - 7th May 1842*
On Saturday last, **Old William Hoggarth**, of Dillicar Mill, in Dillicar, aged 88 years. William from his youth up was miller and maltster. As a maltster he was highly respected by all the landlords in the towns of Kendal, Sedbergh, and Dent, not only for the excellence of the article in which he dealt, but for his honourable disposition as a tradesman and his social disposition as a man.... As a miller, too, was equally respected; - the most suspicious never suspected him of any kind of fraud or injustice. In short, he was beloved by his family and relations, highly respected by his neighbours, acquaintance, and connections; and the world has now (perhaps for the first time) to lament the death of an honest miller.

In 1861 John and Esther are living at Caroline Square, Skipton. John is a labourer. His birthplace is given as Green Dykes, Yorkshire; birth @1794. No children at home.

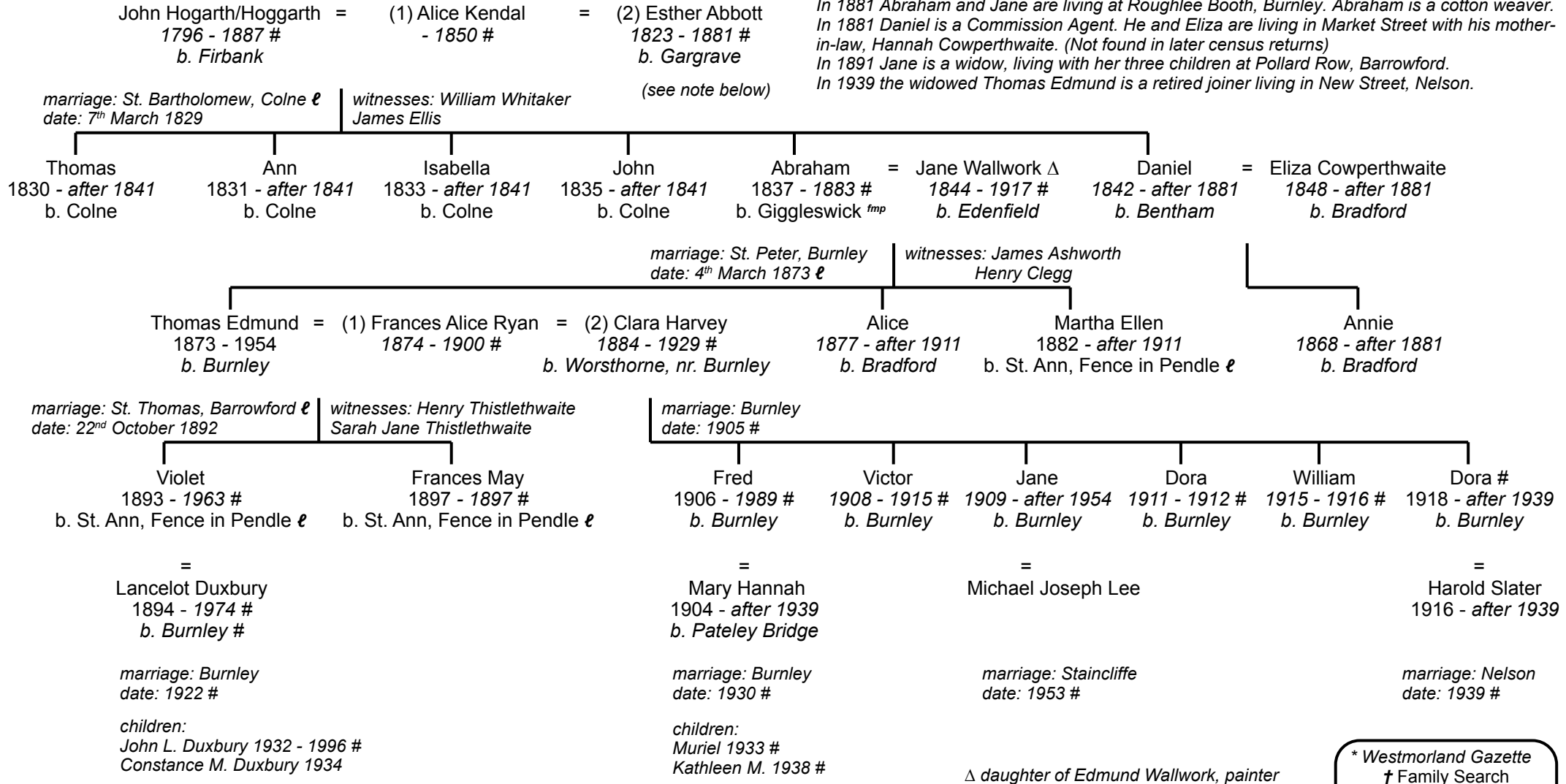
In 1871 John and Esther are living by themselves at Old Hall Yard, Gargrave. John is a labourer.

In 1881 John and Esther are living at Old Hall Fold, Gargrave. John is a rag and bone gatherer born in the neighbourhood of Kendal @1793; Esther a washerwoman aged 50 [sic].
