James Hoggarth and his young family are living at Rusmickle in Crosthwaite according to the 1881 Census. Earlier in the century Thomas & Isabella Lewis and their young family tenanted this same farm.

In 1881 John is still living at home with his parents. After his marriage he farmed at Rath Vale in Pennington where he died in 1932. His brother Robert, retired farmer from High Low Wood, is residing with his widow and family in 1939 at Rath Vale.

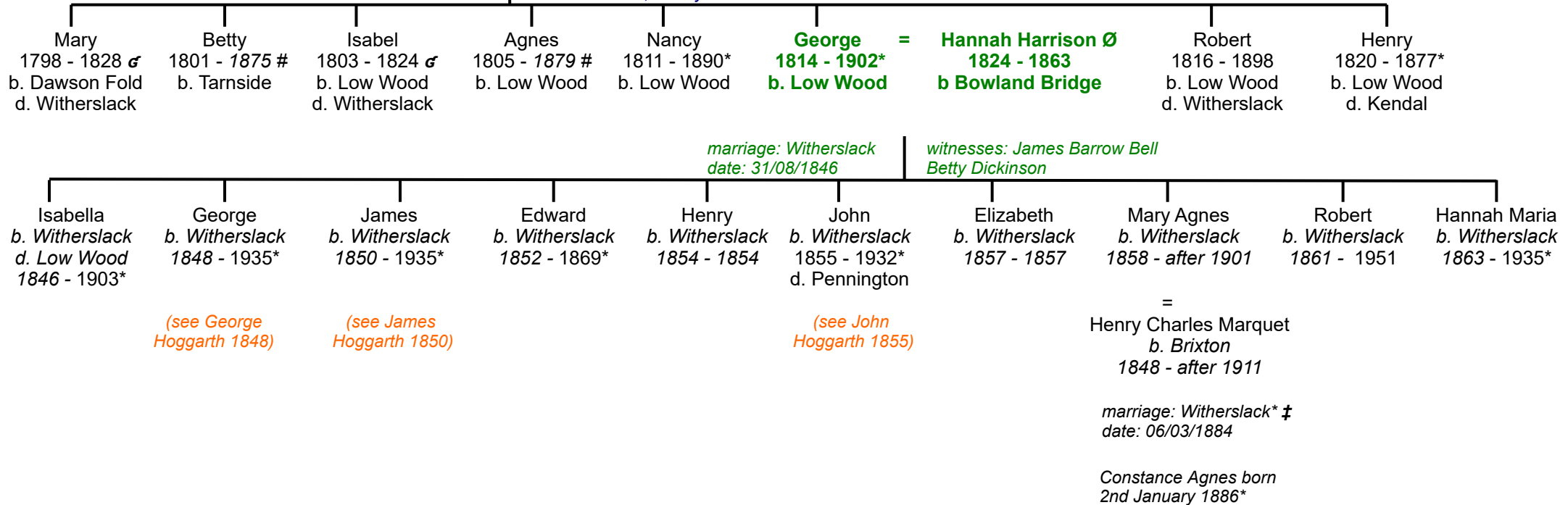
