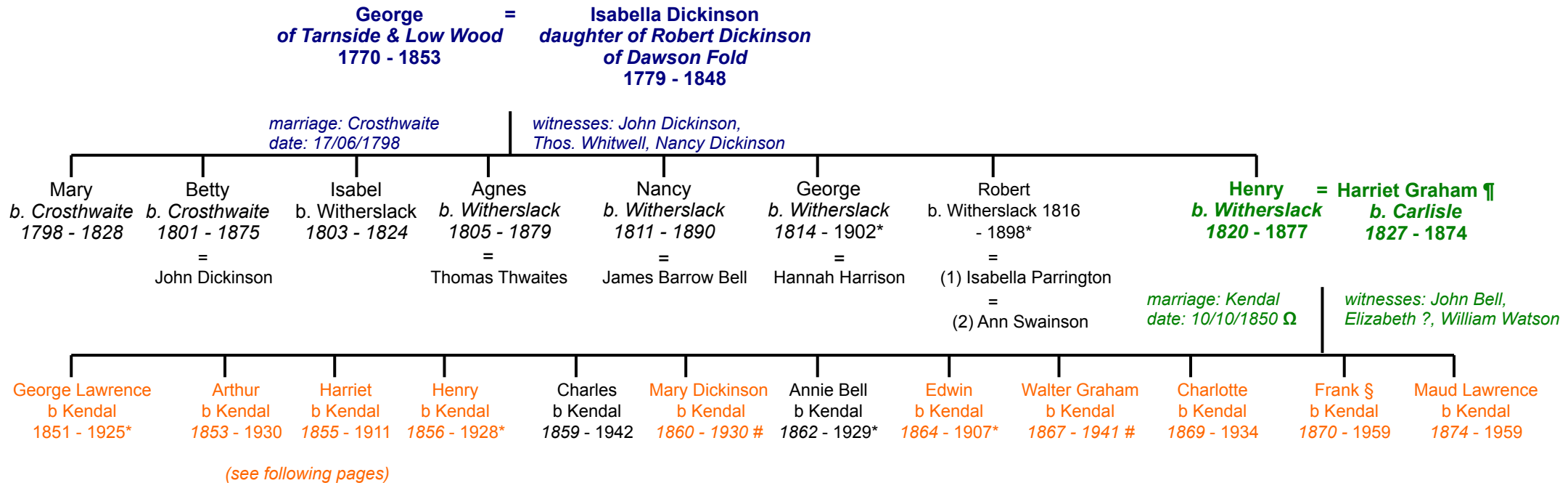

The Dawson Fold inheritance

The children of Arthur Hoggarth included Major Lawrence S. Hoggarth (1881-1962) who married Isobel Alice Robinson (1899-1971). There is a memorial window to them behind the font in St. Mary's Church, Crosthwaite.

From the 1930s they lived at Dawson Fold, Crosthwaite & Lyth.

Mrs Hoggarth was President of the W.I. at Crosthwaite for 39 years. Dawson Fold had been left to Arthur Hoggarth by the Will of William Dickinson in 1884.

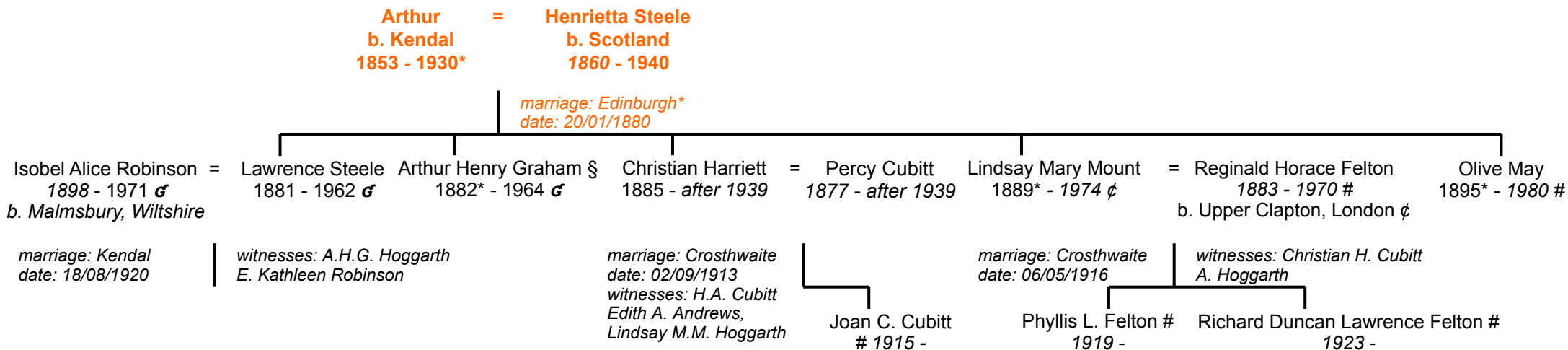

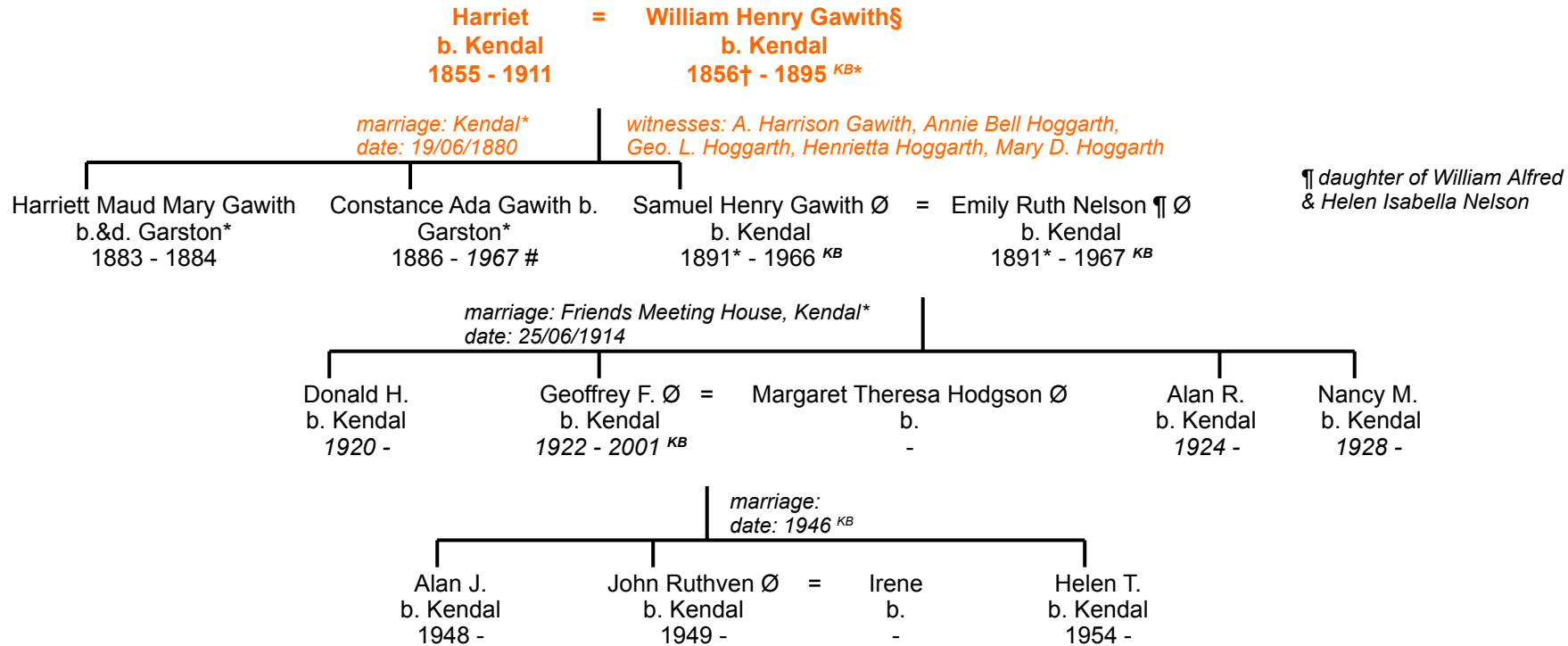
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In 1911, the widowed Harriet is living at 12 Belmont in Kendal.

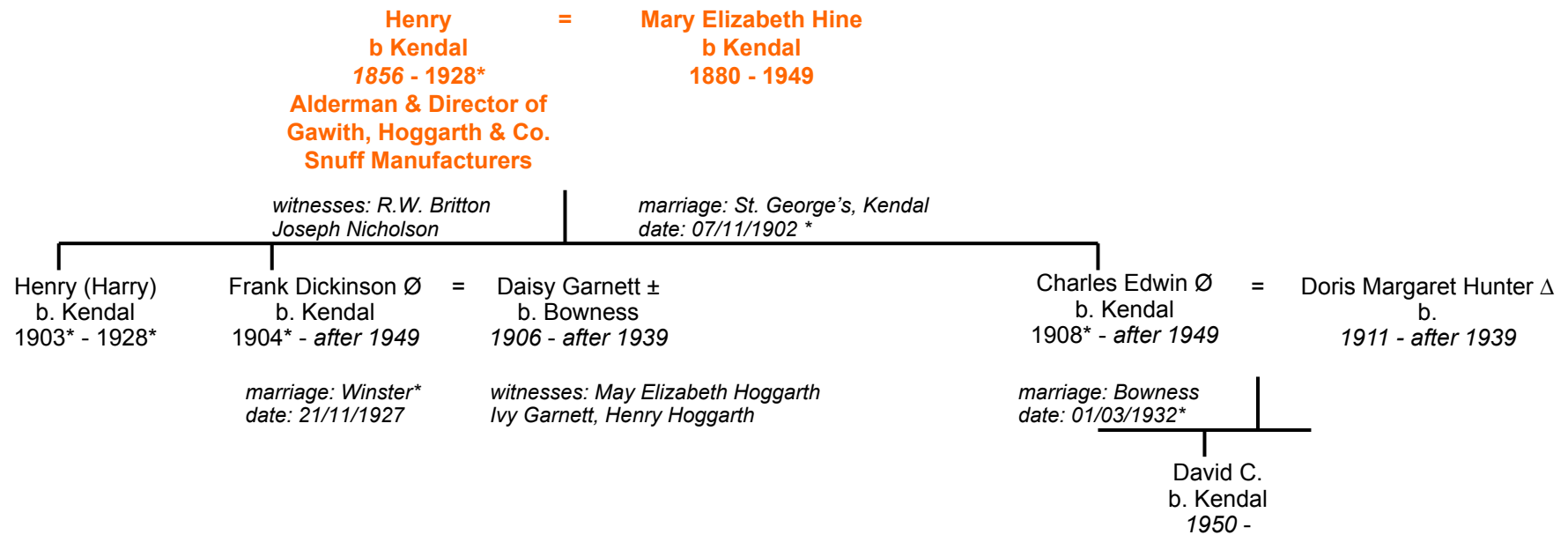

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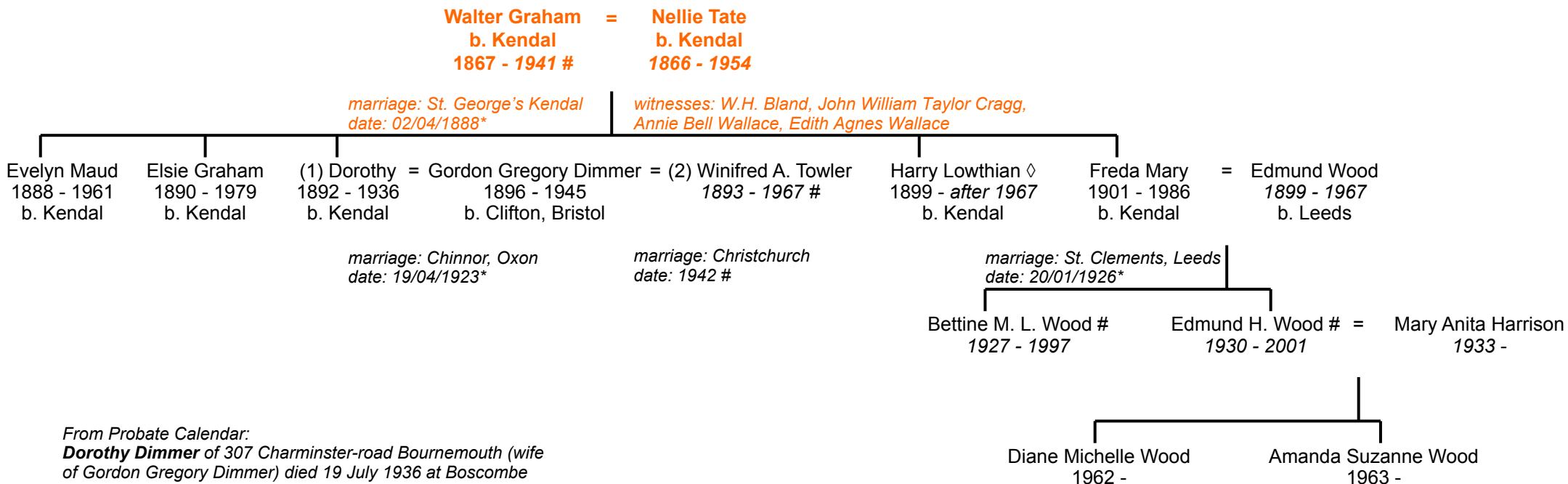

Hylands House, Kendal, the home of Herbert and Charlotte at the time of Herbert's death in 1922. It was built in the Arts and Crafts style by Abraham Pattinson in 1910 and used as a show house. In a personal tribute published in the Westmorland Gazette upon Herbert Baron's death, it is said, "In the laying out of his garden at his new house he spared neither time, money nor trouble, and in spring and summer the grounds were always a blaze of bloom – one often reads of a blaze of bloom, but in this case the expression is not exaggerated."

Sarah Agnes Hogarth is the aunt of Herbert William Baron - see separate document [Highgate Hoggarths](#).

Polonie Tiffin had a French mother and her father was Joseph who was from Cumberland.

Elizabeth Anne Bush is the daughter of William and Mary Ann Bush and is a second cousin twice removed of Charlotte.
