1891 : Henry Dunderdale is living at 102 Main Street, Lancaster, a member of the household of Richard and Hannah Airey. They married in 1879. Hannah's maiden name is Dunderdale. Henry appears to have been her illegitimate child.

1901 : The widowed Henry (Harry), under the name of Airey, is living at 151 Main Street, Lancaster, the home of Richard Airey and his family. Richard is also a widower. He married Mary Ann Lowther in 1901 under his Dunderdale name.

1911: He and his wife Mary Ann are under the name of Airey in the 1911 census and living at 42 Croft Street, Morecambe. There are children.

1939: Henry and Mary Ann Airey are living at 39 Main Street, Lancaster. Henry is a general dealer.

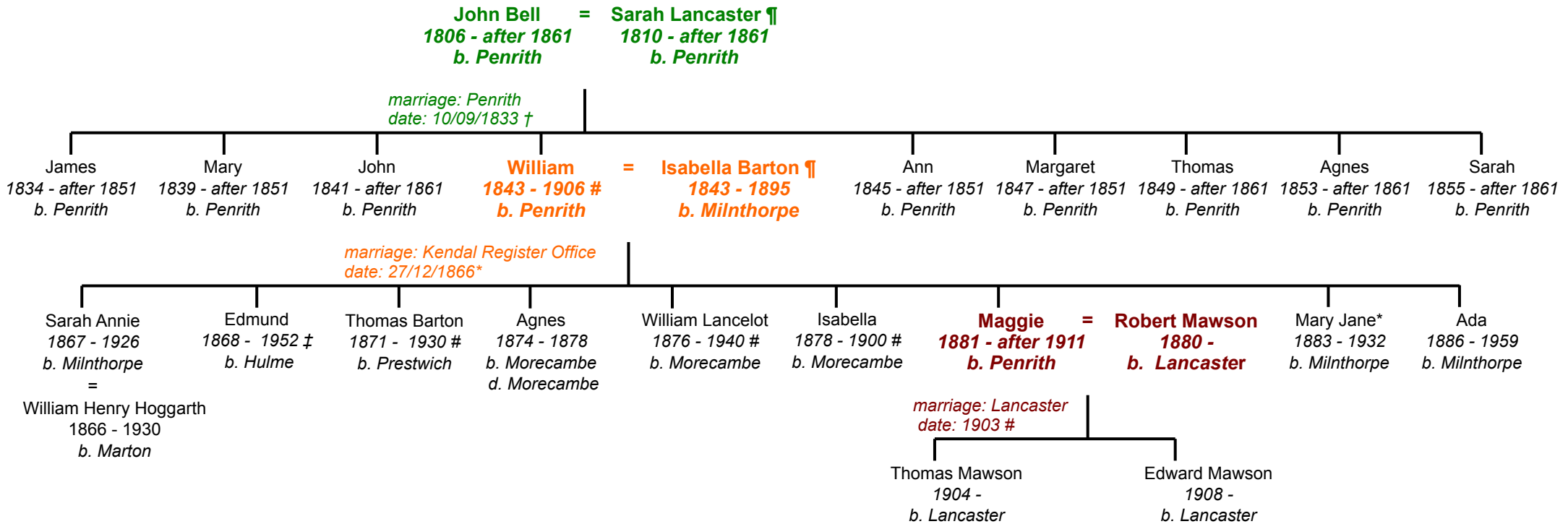

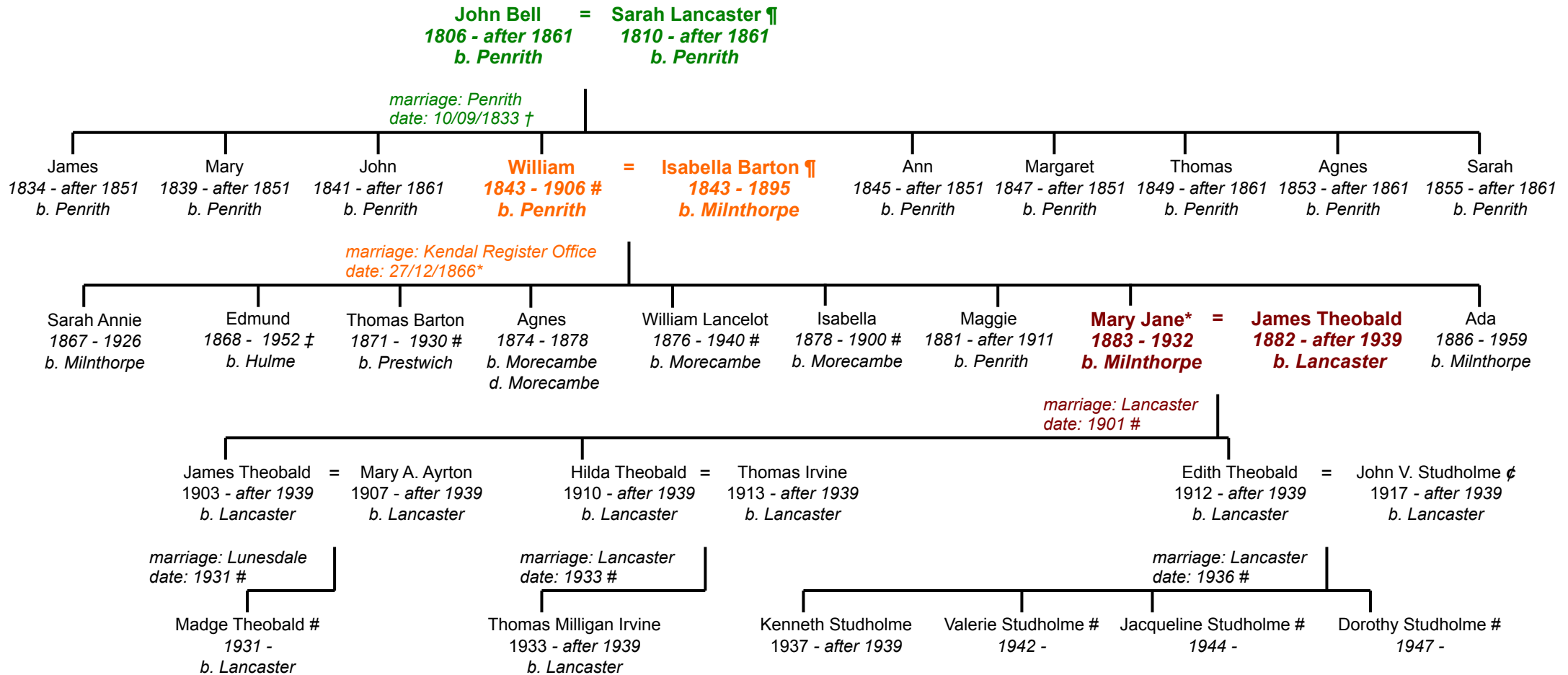

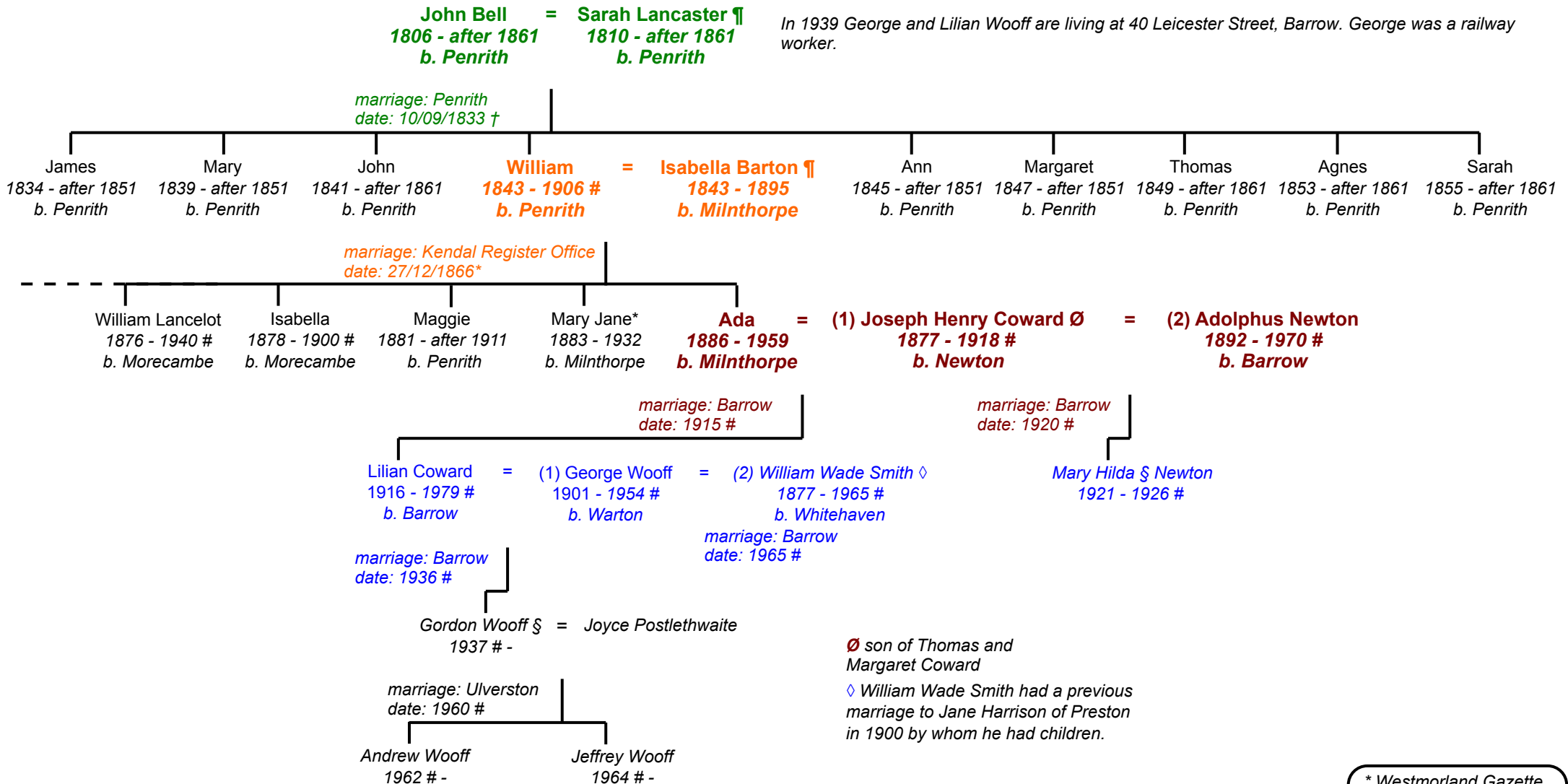
