‡ These brothers enlisted in World War I. Herbert was the first to do so and was reported in hospital in Kent by the Westmorland Gazette in December 1916 and was again in a Canadian hospital in France in late 1917.

¶ John living in Islington with two young daughters & two unmarried sisters in 1901.

¶ James joined the army briefly in 1896, discharged because of epilepsy. Married Jane Elizabeth Northover in 1900. Son Jack died aged 8 months in 1902* His wife died in 1907* He died later that year in Nova Scotia* There appears to have been a daughter Mabel born 1903 who married Samuel Alderson at Windermere 4th October 1928*, stated by the Westmorland Gazette to be the granddaughter of Mrs. Northover - see Rigg - Northover

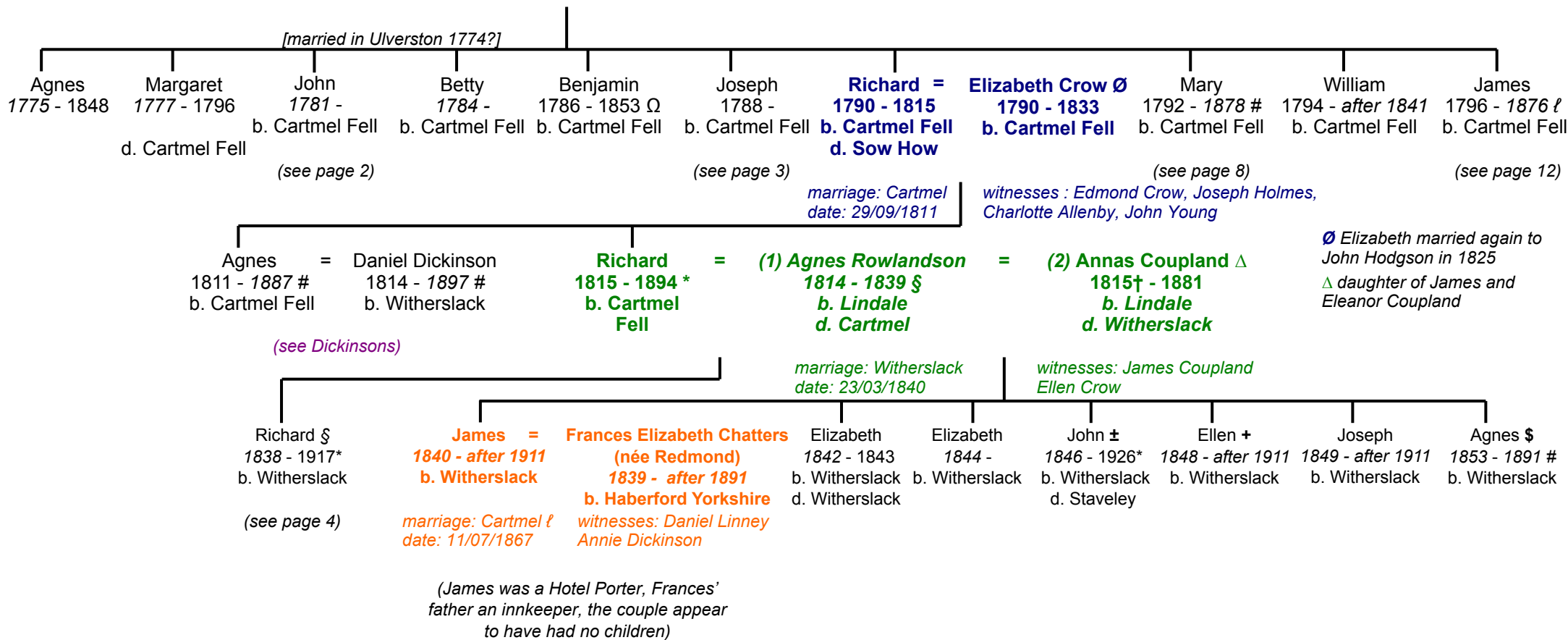

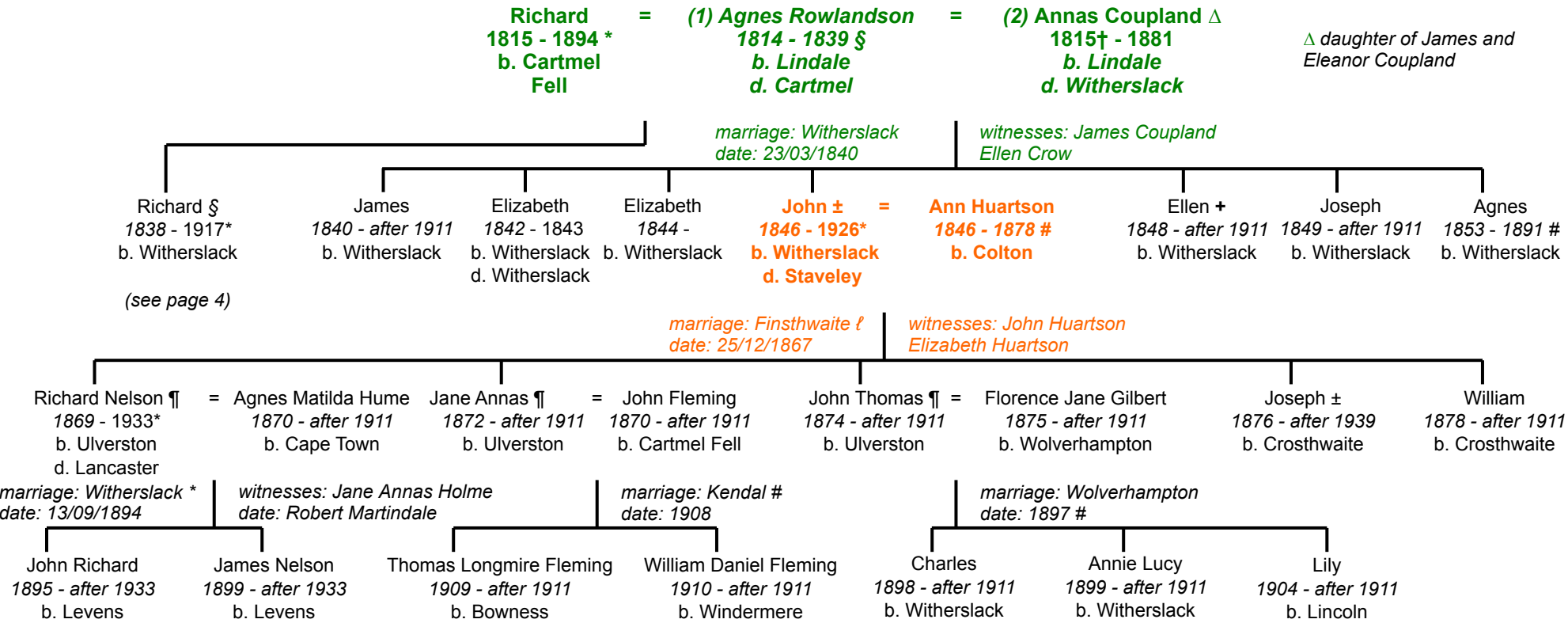
± John, a shoemaker, recently widowed, was living at Borderside in 1881. He re-married in 1896 to widow Jane Thornborough.

+ Ellen married William Otway at Witherslack in 1869. Elizabeth Matthews was a witness to the marriage. William is an agricultural labourer at Spa Inn Witherslack in 1871, Town End Cottage in 1881 & 1891. Ellen is widowed by 1901.

§ Agnes married Edward Proctor in 1884. They had one daughter, Millicent, in 1891 when Widower Richard was living with them in Heversham. Edward married again after Agnes' death.

± Joseph is a blacksmith in Austwick in 1901 & 1911. He married Lydia Wilson from Endmoor in 1901. No children in 1911.

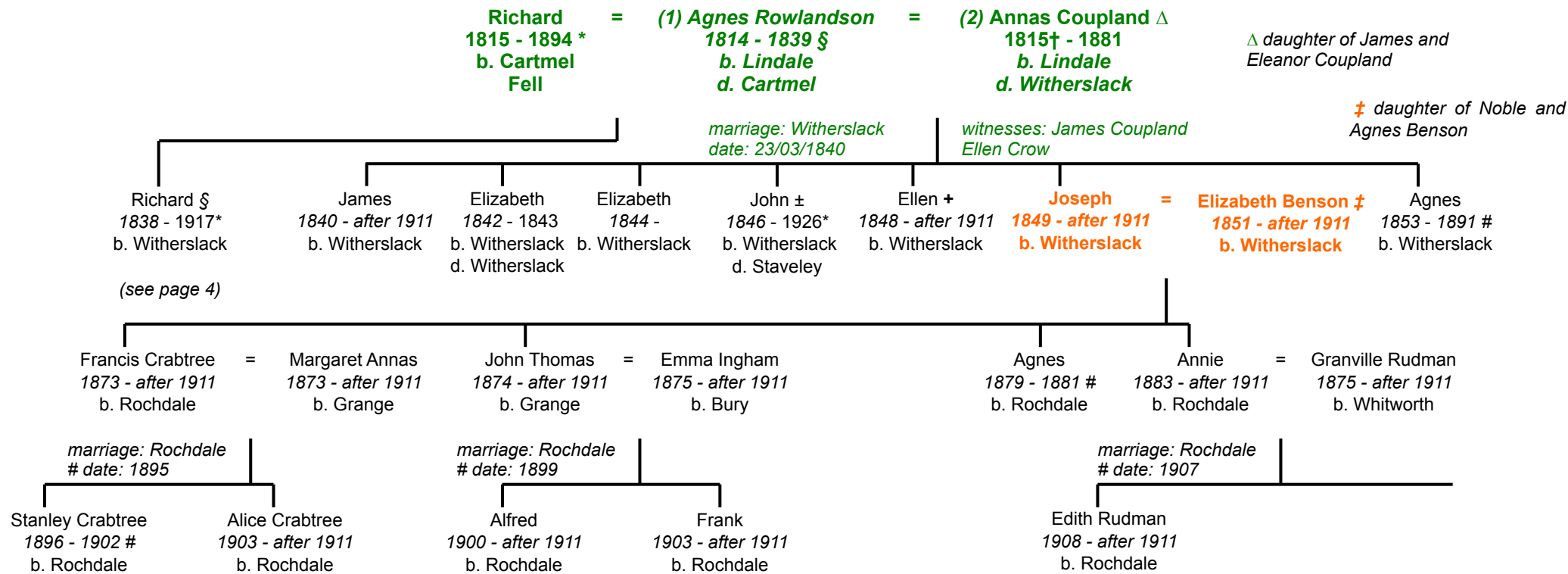

Joseph and Elizabeth are on their own in 1911, and said to have had 5 children, 3 still living.

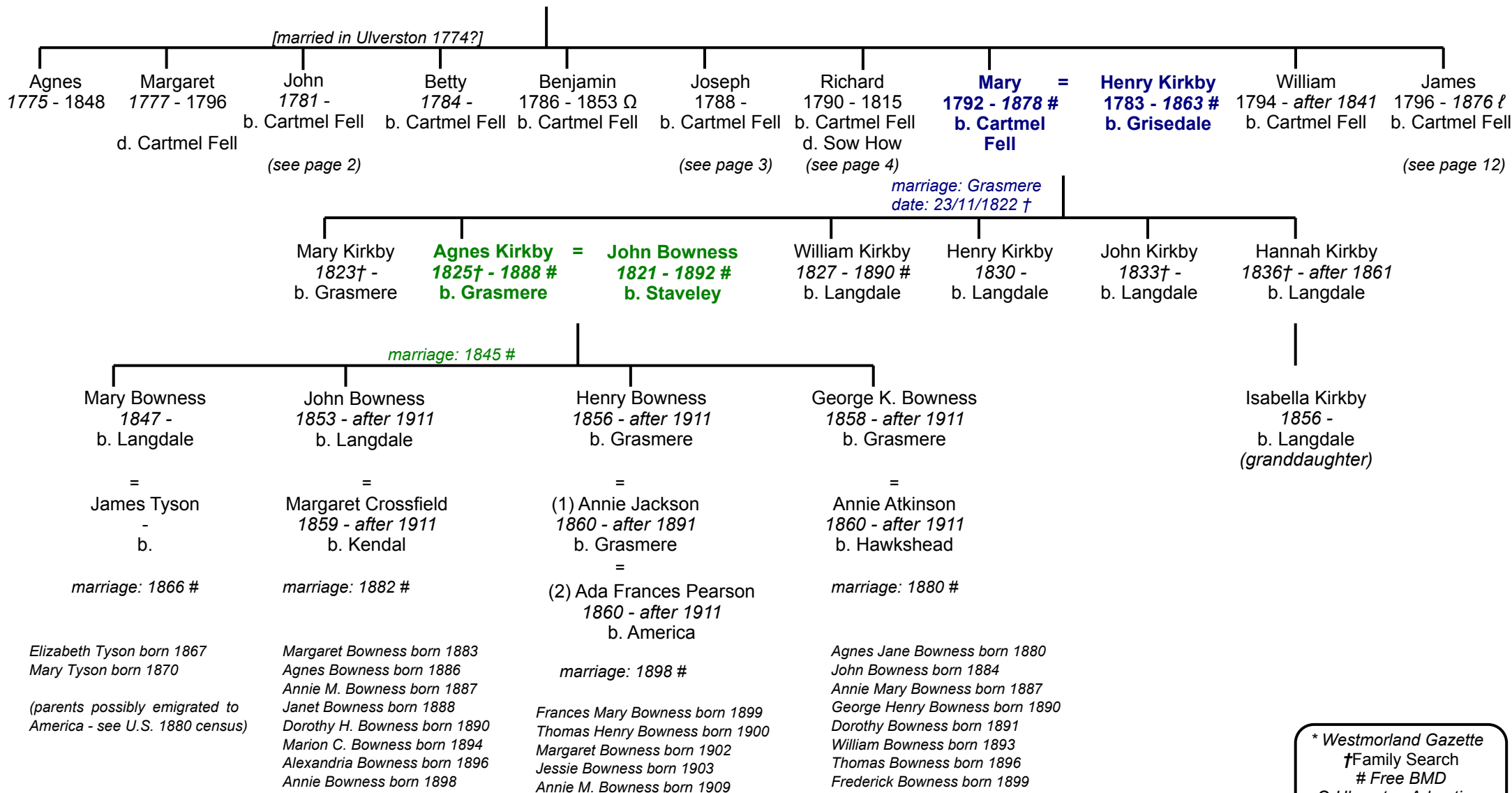

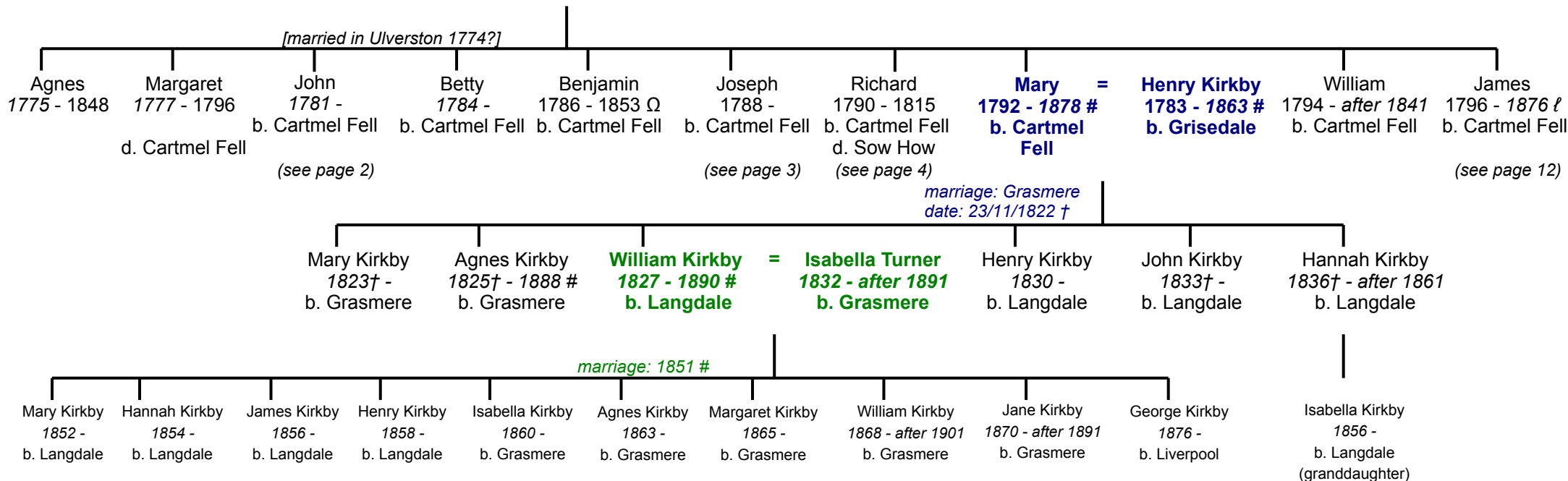

 In 1891 Isabella is widowed and living with two of her children in Walton.

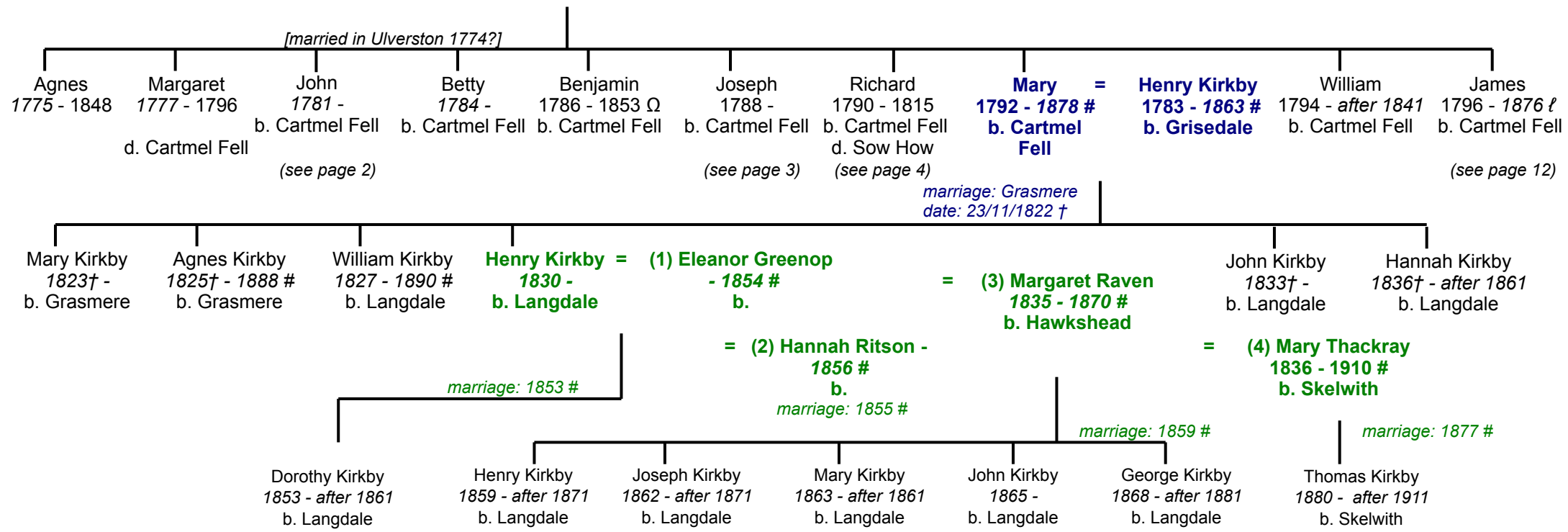
