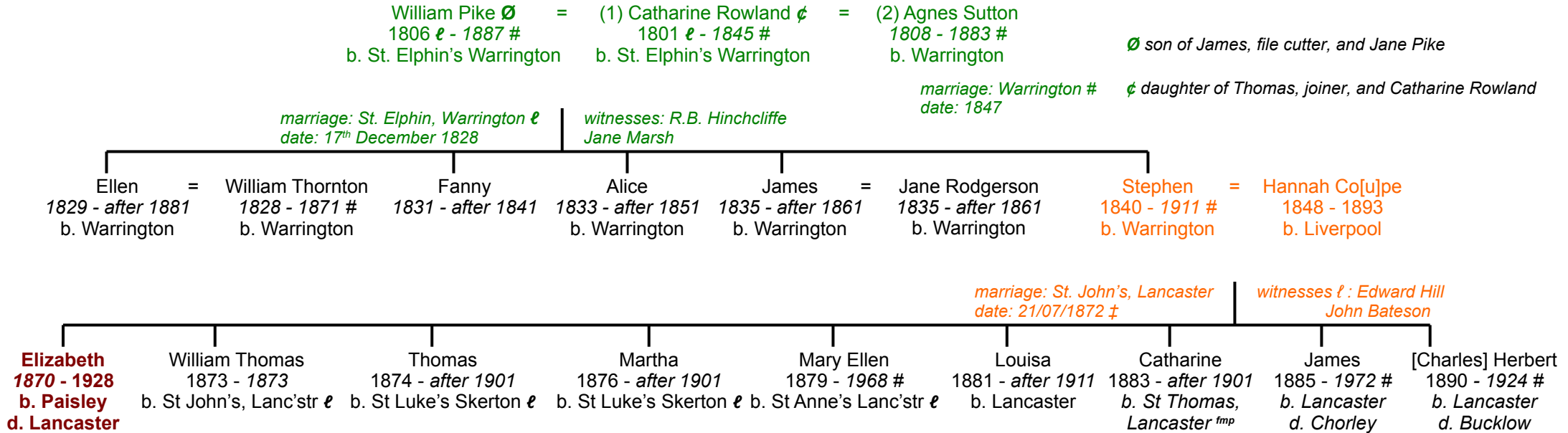

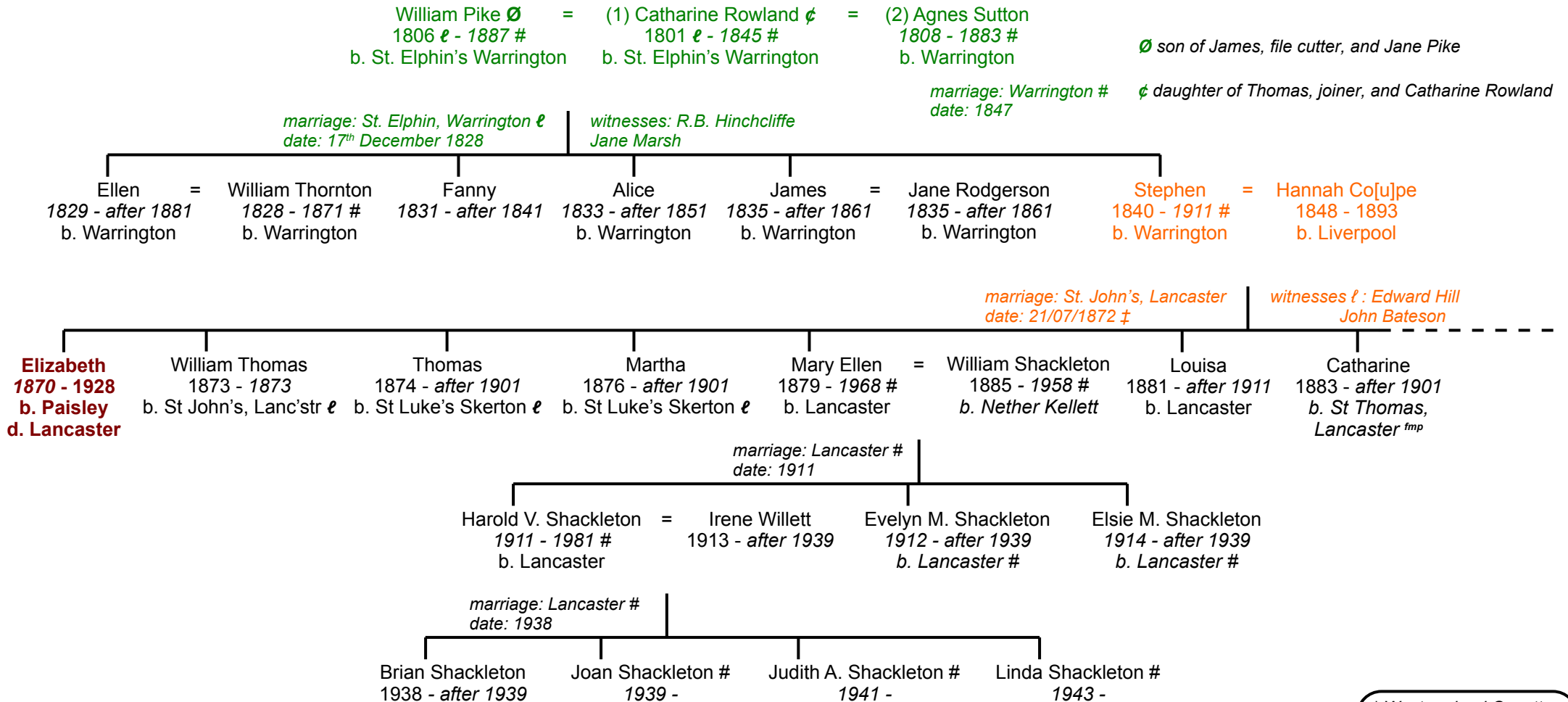

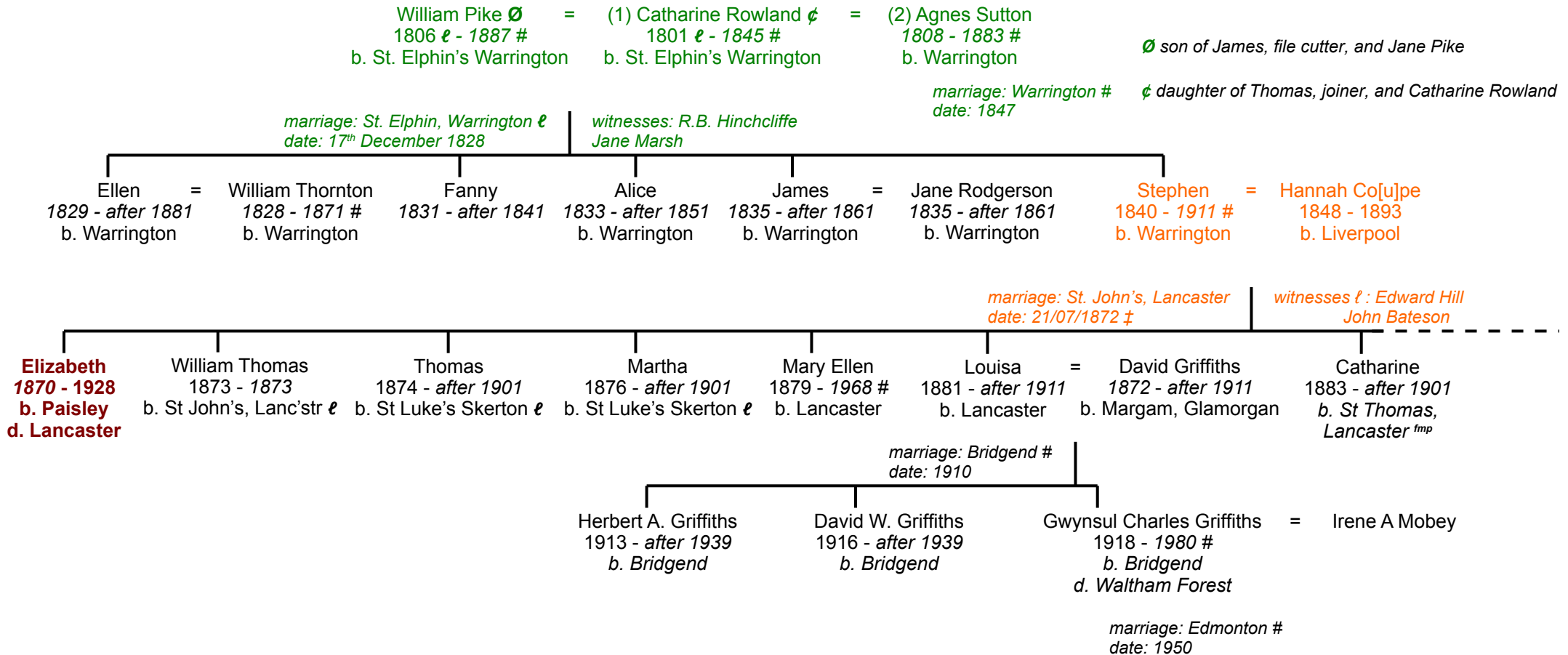

In 1939 James Pyke is a retail grocer's assistant living at 6 Percy Road, Lancaster, with Maryon, Herbert and Nancy.

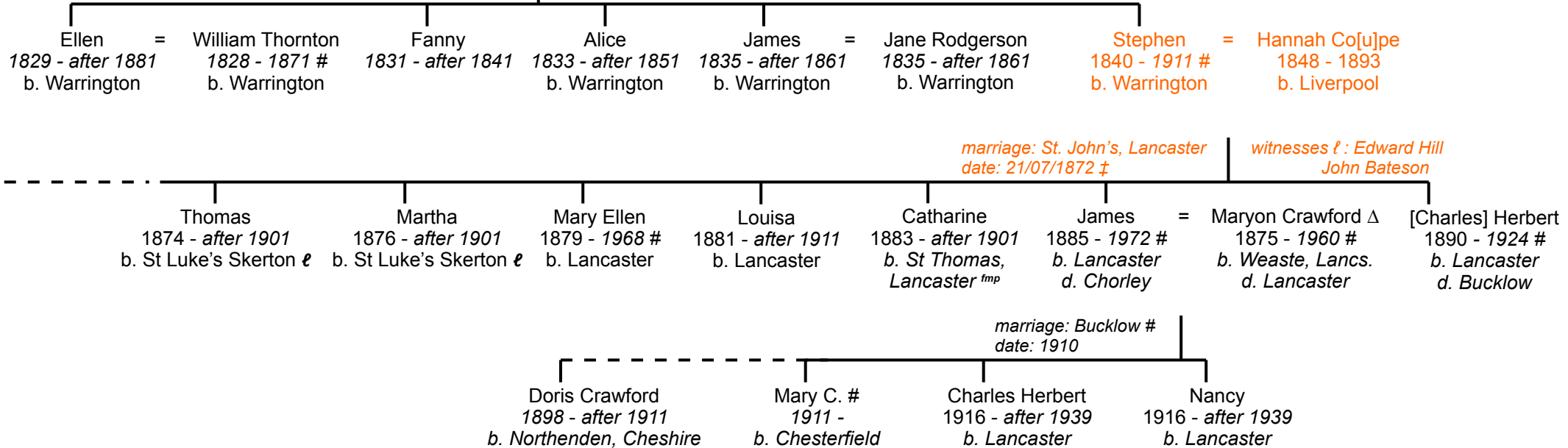

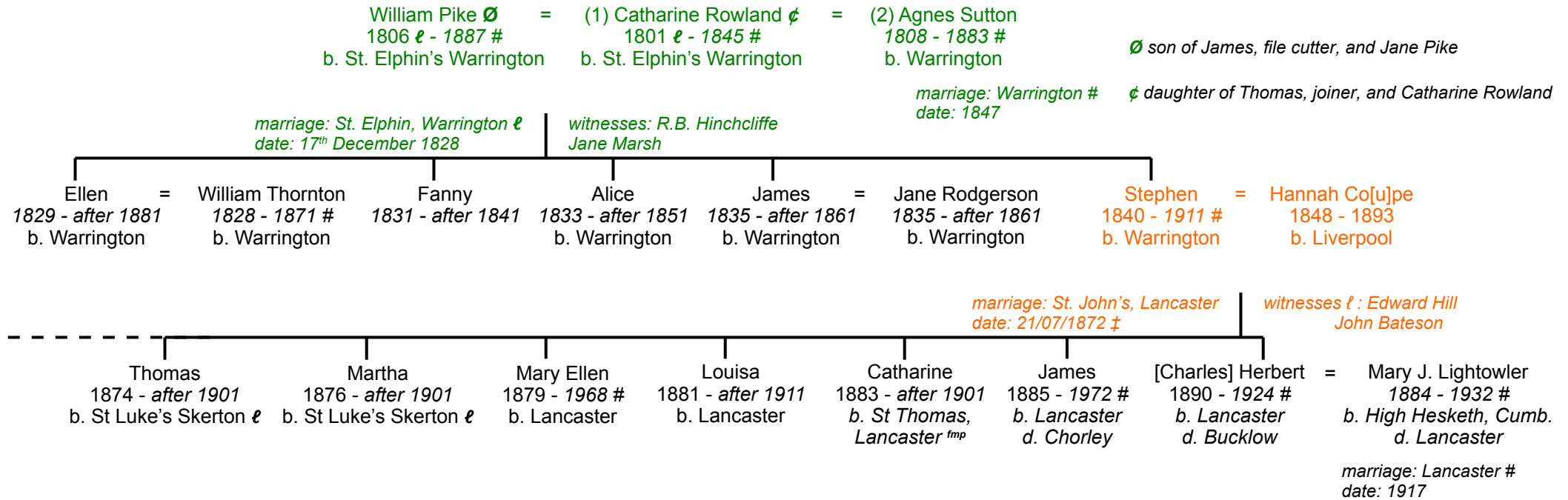
