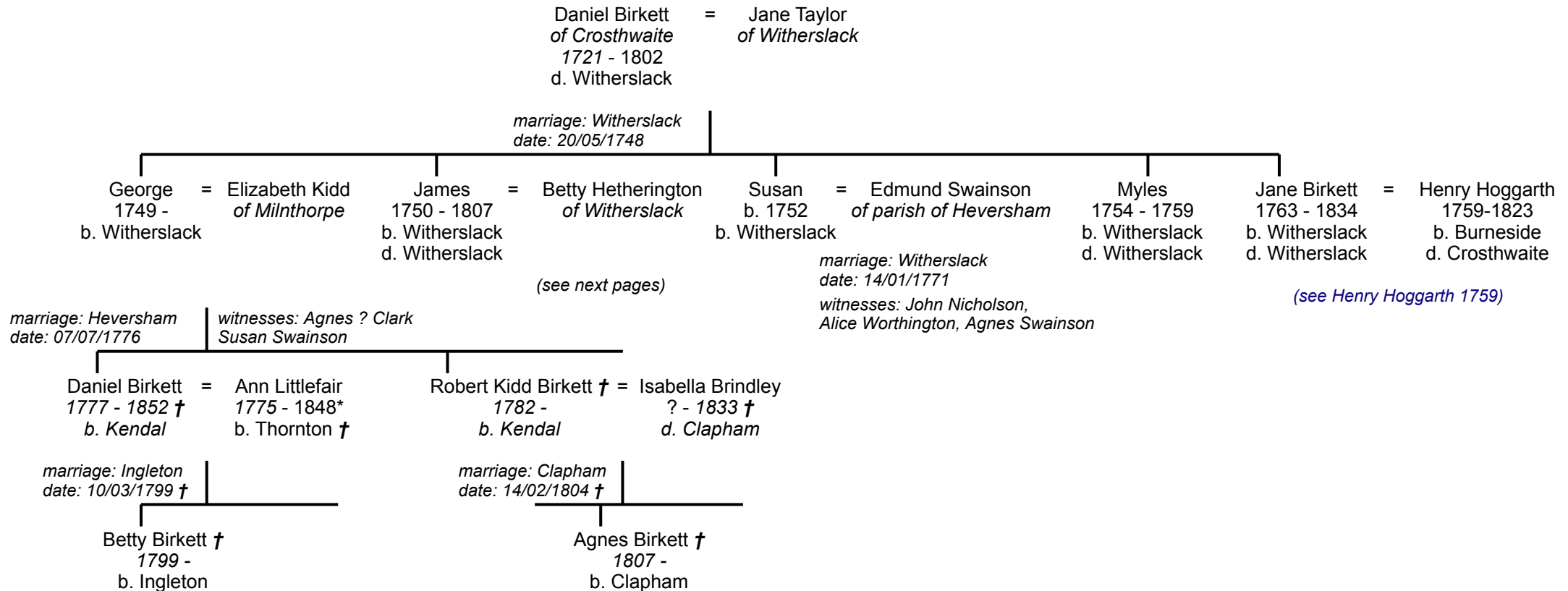

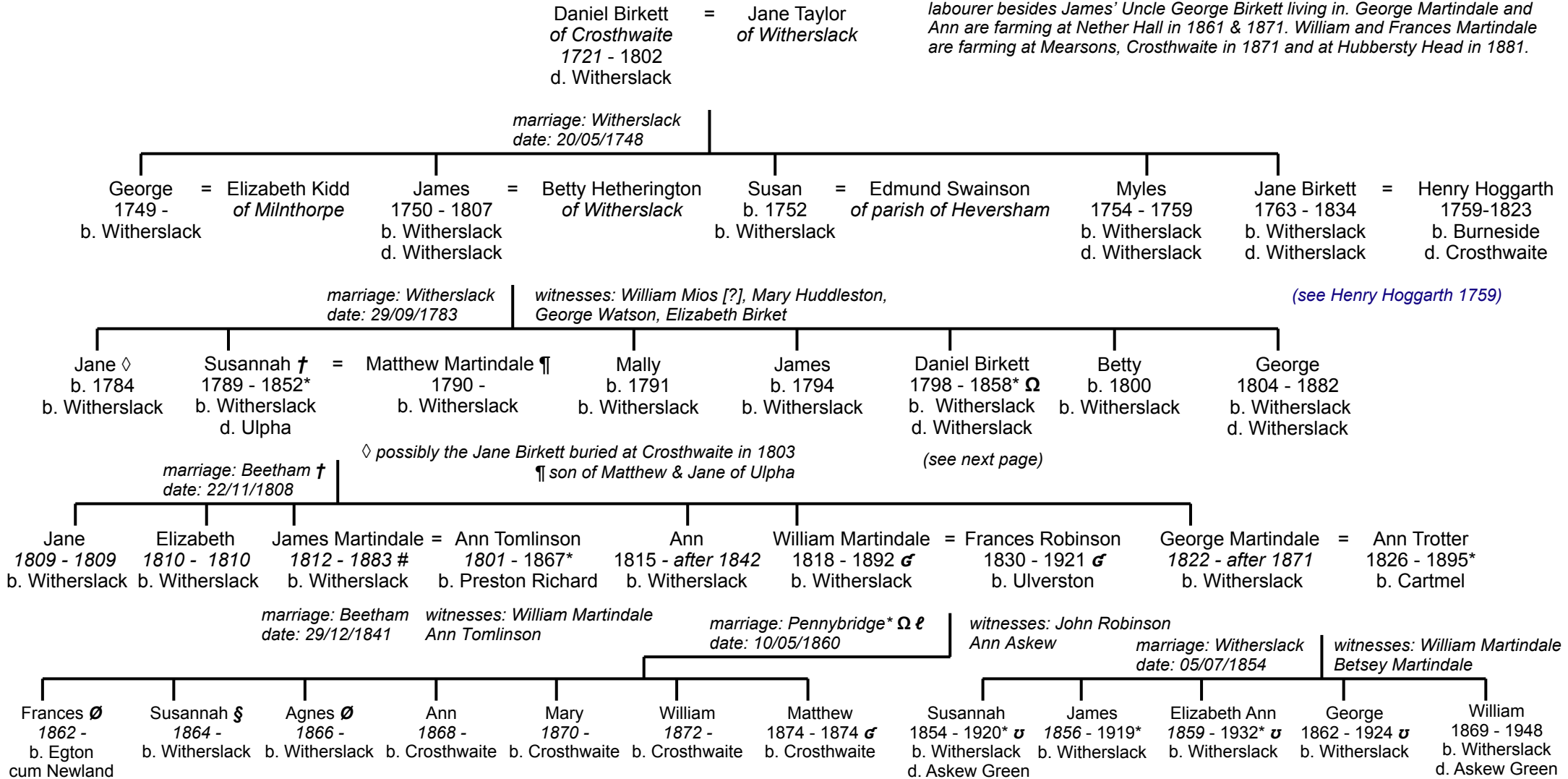

James was recorded as a farmer and housekeeper of Low Wood, and a paralytic, when he was buried in 1807

James Martindale and Ann are farming at Ulpha Farm in 1861. The farm is of 250 acres. There are four servants, two dairy maids and an agricultural labourer besides James' Uncle George Birkett living in. George Martindale and Ann are farming at Nether Hall in 1861 & 1871. William and Frances Martindale are farming at Mearsons, Crosthwaite in 1871 and at Hubbersty Head in 1881.

*Richard said to have been the landlord of the Derby Arms for 31 years.

*Isabella died at the Lancaster Royal Grammar School, on 22nd December 1861, after a short and severe illness.

Richard Parrington was the Innkeeper at The Derby Arms Inn when his daughter Catherine was buried on 26th September 1821, the same day that his daughter Isabella was baptised, and was so on Census night in 1851.

Their son in law is a husbandman at Longhow End in 1824.

1861: The widowed Elizabeth Birkett is the Victualler at the Derby Arms Inn

1871: Richard Birkett is the Innkeeper and his sister Catherine the Land Lady of the Derby Arms Inn

1881: Robert Hoggarth is farmer and Innkeeper at the Derby Arms Inn; Richard Birkett is now an Agricultural Labourer at James Dickinson's farm, Turner Hill. Catherine is a cook at a farm in the Fylde and listed as a widow.

1891: The Inn has passed to John Downing from Sheffield and his wife Eleanor (née Myers), a local Innkeeper's daughter.

1901: The Inn has passed to John & Annie Askew from Ingleton. Annie dies in 1909

1911: The Inn is still in the hands of the widowed John Askew. He died at Grange over Sands in April 1925*

Ø married William Cape, 23rd February 1839 at Witherslack. He is the Innkeeper at the Punch Bowl, Crosthwaite in 1841 & 1851. The family is next to be found at Low Meathop when his mother- in-law died in July 1861* & in 1871, 1881 & 1891.

¶ Eleanor married William Butterworth, chair maker, of Manchester.

Elizabeth married John Kirkby at Witherslack on 2nd June 1848.

Susannah married John Satterthwaite at Ulverston on 22nd January 1863*

Jane married Joseph Clark at Witherslack on 20th October 1869*

Eleanor Jane married John Askew, at Ilkley on 14th September 1897*, living at the Horse & Farrier Inn, High Newton in 1901 & 1911.
