 William Dixon was an iron ore miner at Lindal in Furness in 1871, also in 1881 by which time he and Margaret had four daughters, & in 1891 Thomas Tyson was a quarryman at Osmotherly in 1871, by which time he and Hannah had four sons. He was a slate quarryman at Subberthwaite in 1881, a widower, five sons and a daughter. Continued at Subberthwaite in the same occupation 1891 & 1901, retired and living alone in 1911.

**Jacob** is farming at Pattison How at the birth of Jacob, Ellen, Edmund, and John Jacob is farming at Swallowmire at the birth of William in 1823 and in 1842. **John Airey** is said to be a husbandman at Swallowmire when Jacob, Agnes & Sarah are born, but a labourer at Ayside when John is born in 1848 and in the 1851 census. The family is at Bleuart Tenement when Elizabeth Eleanor is born. John is a labourer at Low House, Raw, in Crosthwaite in 1861, but is away in 1871 as a servant at his Sister in Law's, Hannah Airey (Crow, née Watson) at Cunsey in Satterthwaite. In 1881 John and Ellen are at Lindal in Furness along with daughter Margaret. They are not many doors away from James & Agnes Lewis. John is a farm labourer. **Jacob** after being a farm servant is a miner in Marton with a young family in 1871. The family is still in Marton in 1881, and Jacob is an Insurance Agent. In 1891 Jacob is a Green Grocer at 1 Marsh Street, Askam. Having re-married Jacob is a Grocer in Chapel Street, Dalton, in 1901. The couple are in Ulverston in 1911. His son **John** is a coal merchant in Barrow in 1901, a fish dealer in Duke Street, Askam, in 1911.



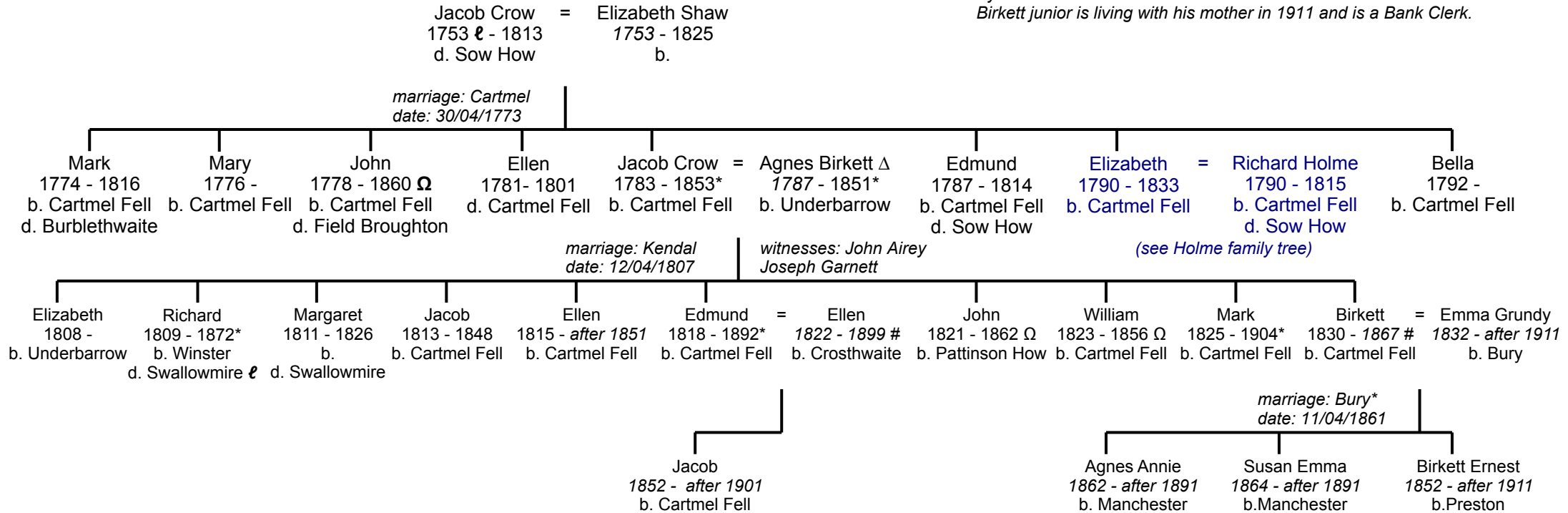
