Chapel Hill consists of three houses, one recently built by **Mr. Richard Holme**, in which he now resides: Mr. Holme is brother to the Rev. William Holme, of Emmanuel College, Cambridge. The late Mr. John Holme, father of the above gentleman, was a most respectable and intelligent man. Mr. Holme, with much kindness, occasionally received travellers in his house to eat and to lodge, there being no public house nearer Haws Water than Bampton, which is six miles from Chapel Hill, and two from the foot of the lake. An ancestor of the family of Holme settled anciently in these parts, and the Holmes of Mardale have lived here ever since the reign of King John.
