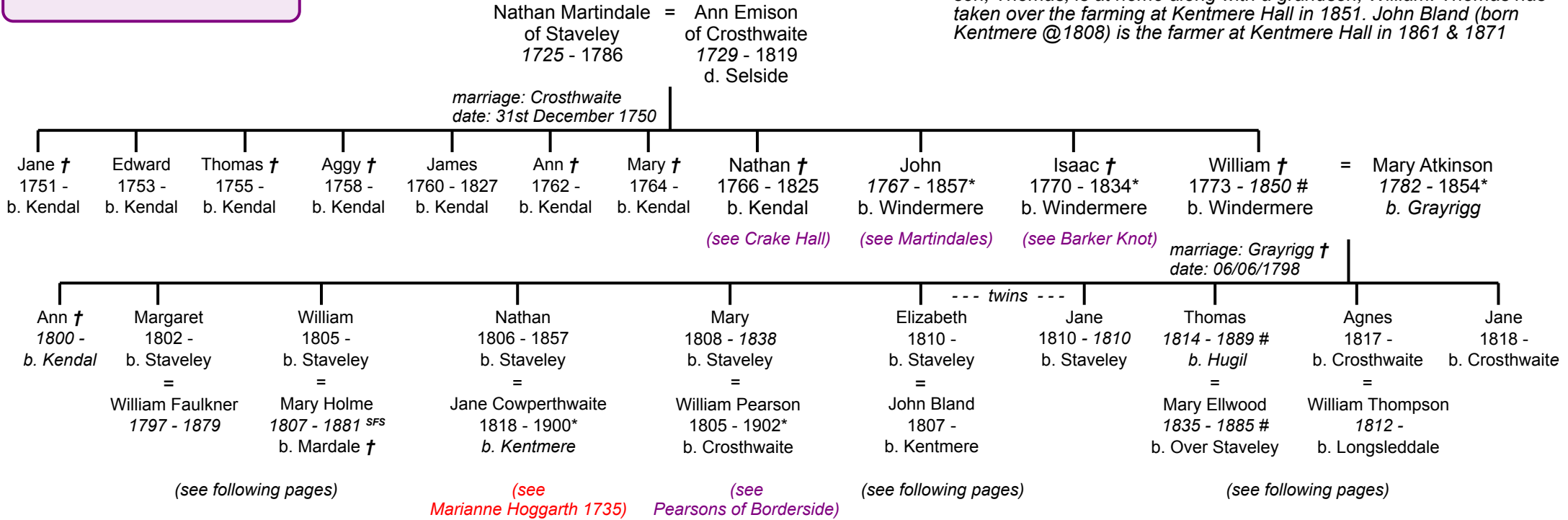

In 1871 William Faulkner is a meal and flour dealer, living with his wife and son, Frederick, and granddaughter Mary Ann at Netherfield, Nethergraveship.
In 1881 the widowed Margaret is living with two of her grandchildren in Highgate, Kendal.

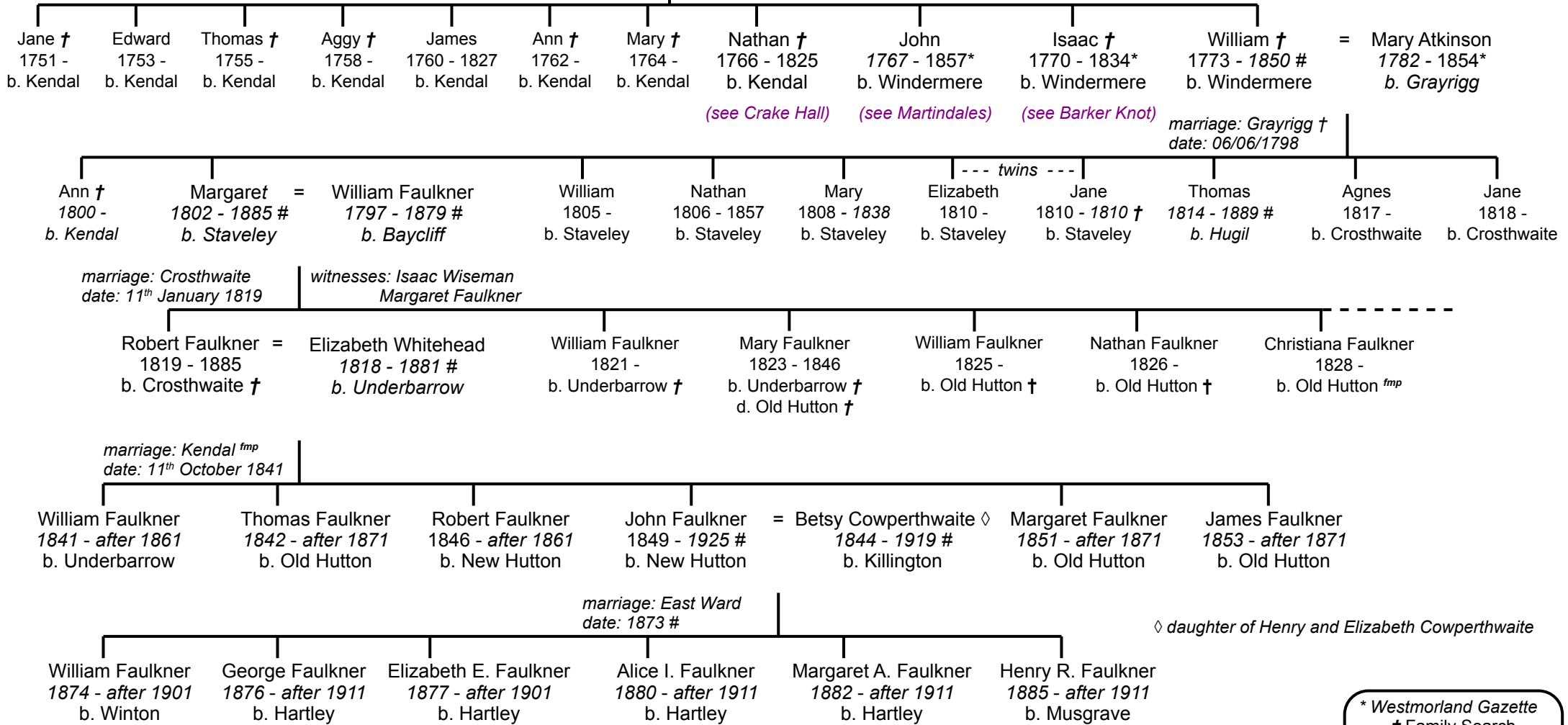

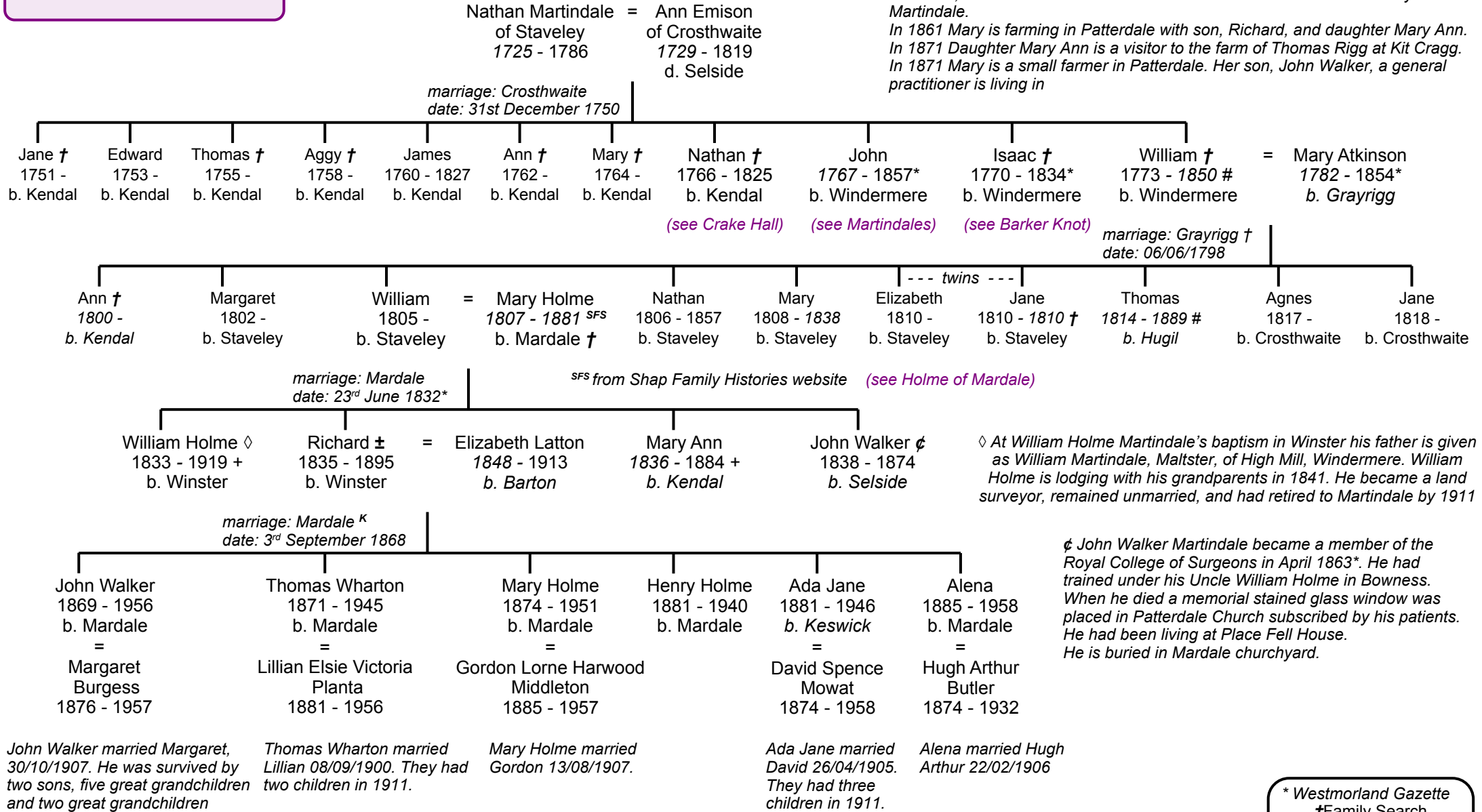

In 1861 Mary is farming in Patterdale with son, Richard, and daughter Mary Ann. In 1871 Daughter Mary Ann is a visitor to the farm of Thomas Rigg at Kit Cragg. In 1871 Mary is a small farmer in Patterdale. Her son, John Walker, a general practitioner is living in

Thomas is a farmer and landowner farming at Green Hills, Bongate, in 1871. William Ellwood, a nephew, is a farm servant.
Thomas is a farmer of 170 acres at Stool End, Langdale in 1881. William Ellwood along with his brother Edward and sister Annie is farming at Stool End in 1891. In 1901 the recently married Edward is at Bull Pot Farm, Casterton. By 1911 there had been three children, one of whom had died.

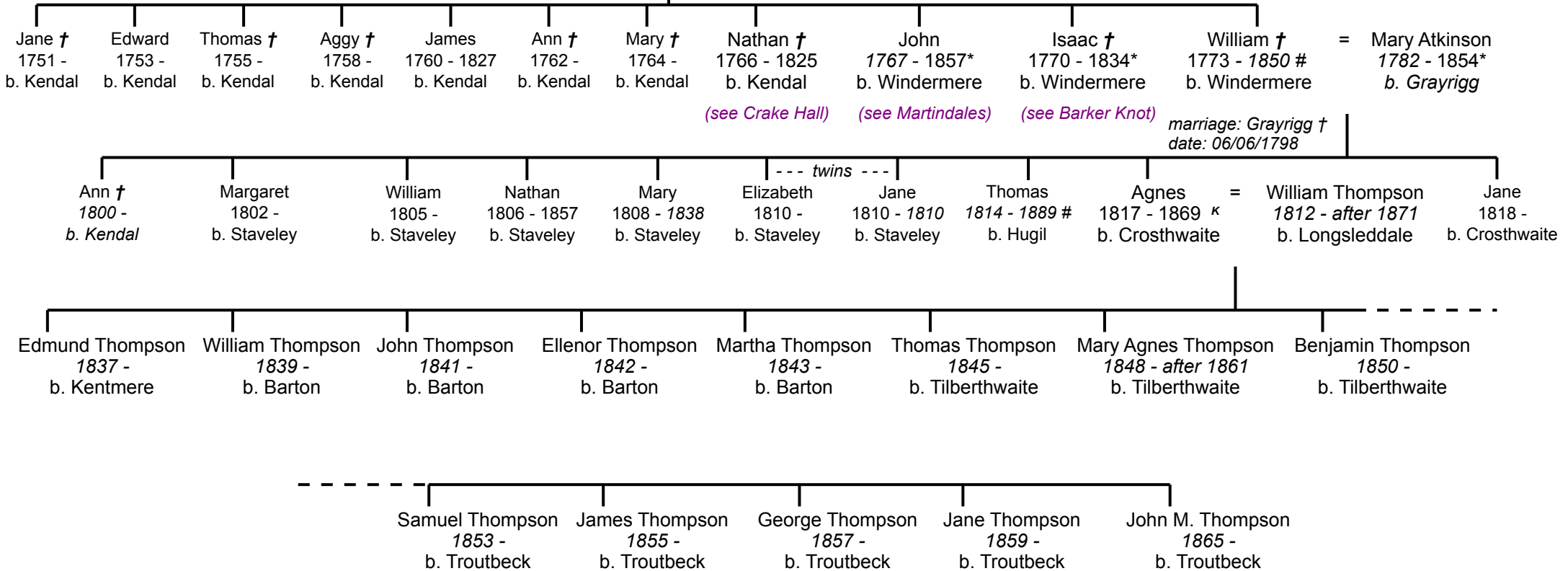

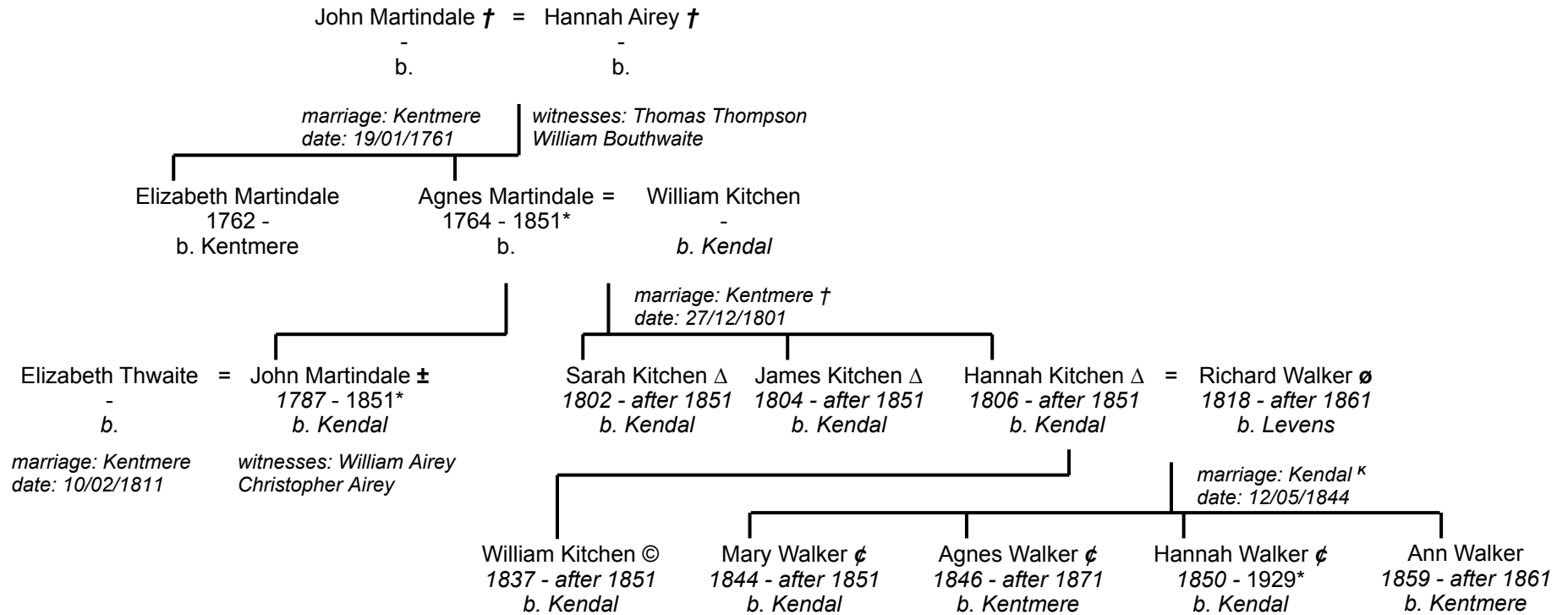
