Ø George married a second time to Anne Maria Vaughan in 1888. They had children besides two children from Anna's previous marriage.

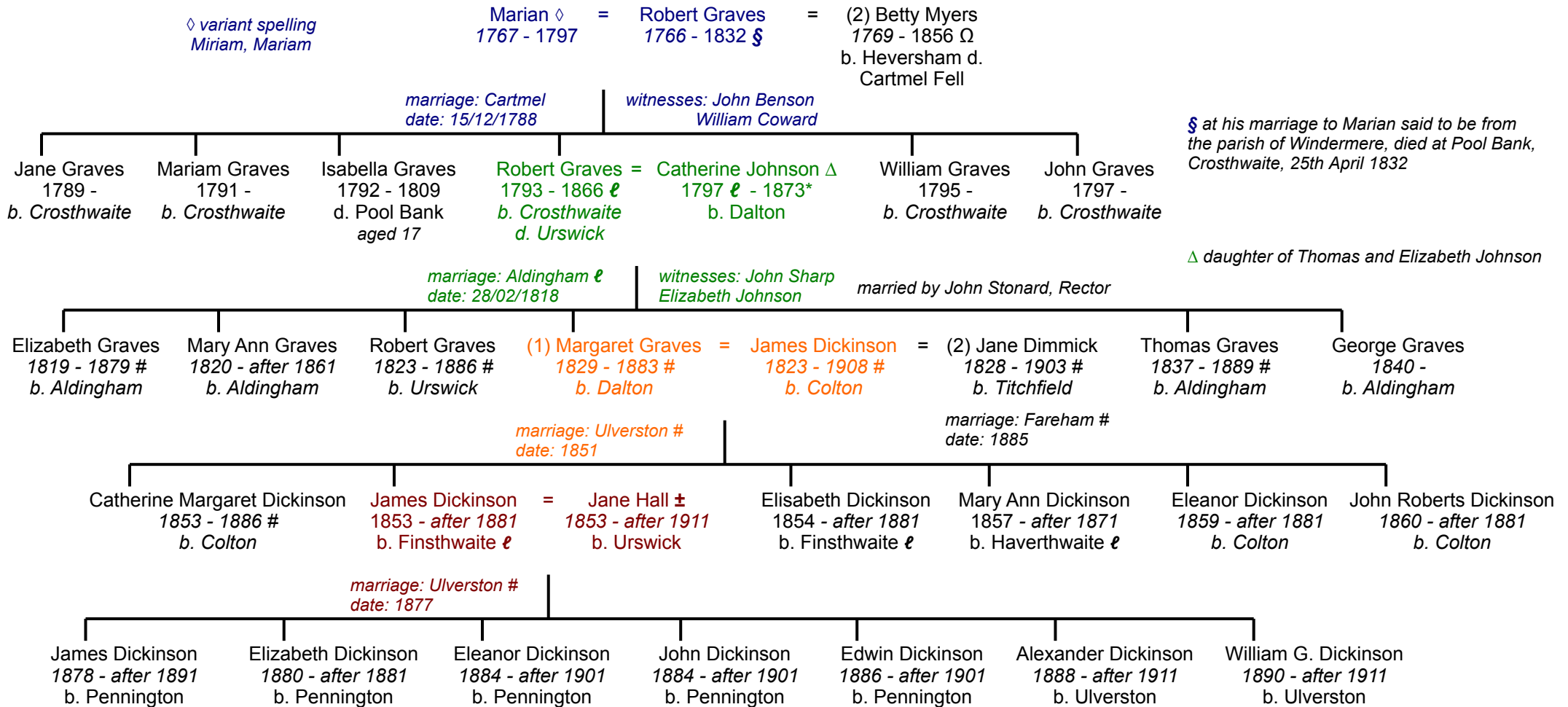
