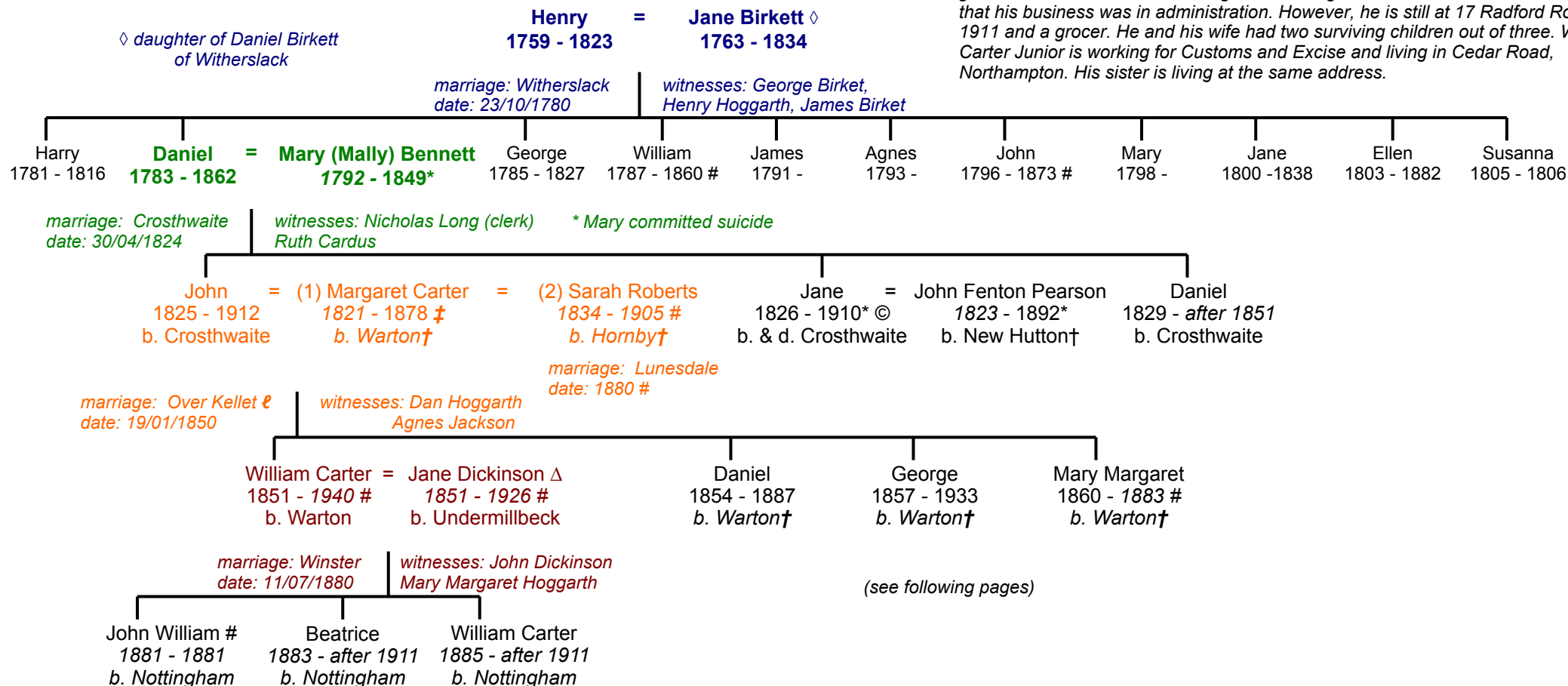

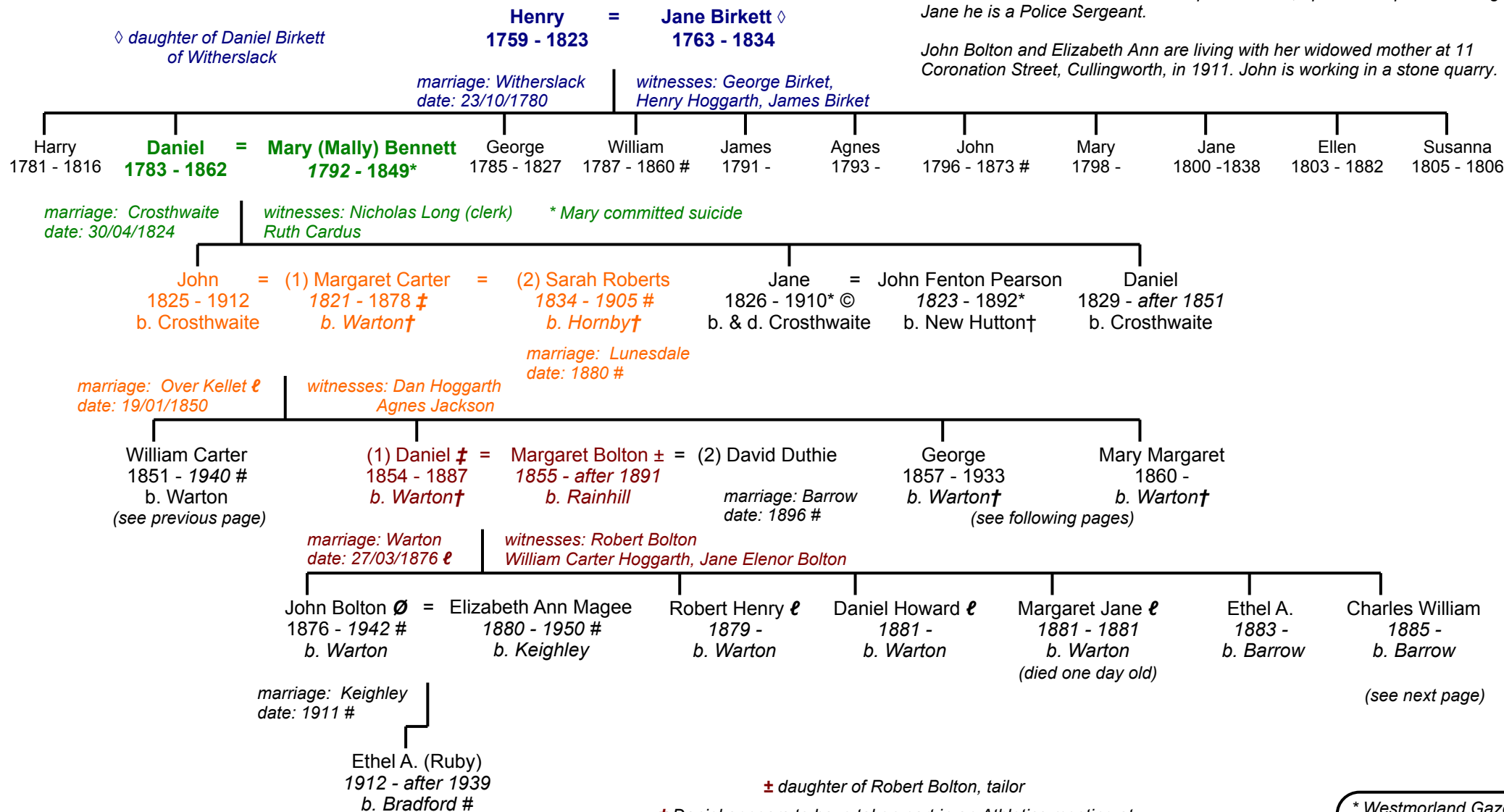

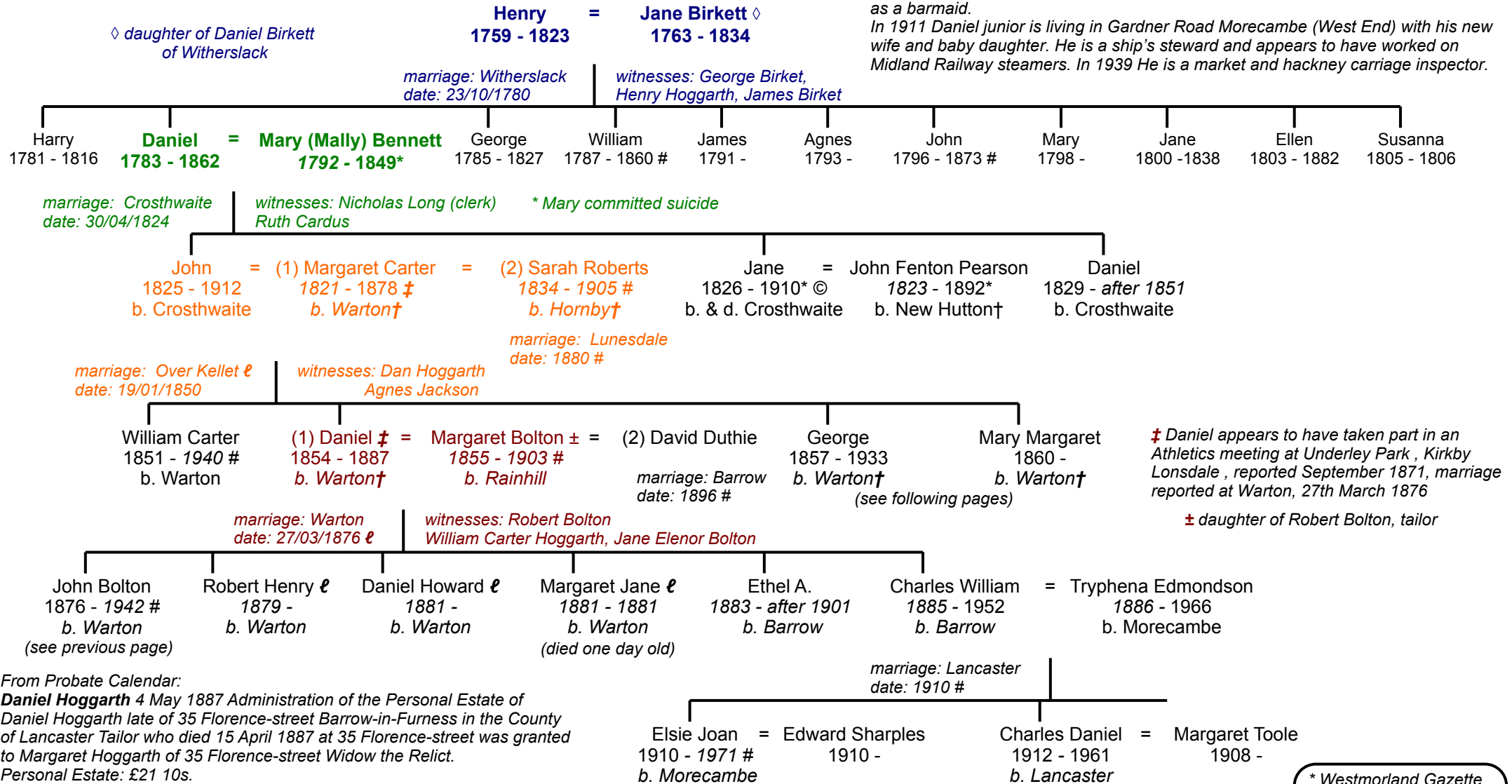

The Warton Parish Registers record Daniel Hoggarth senior as being a Police Constable in Barrow when John Bolton was baptised. Later, upon the baptism of Margaret Jane he is a Police Sergeant.

In 1901 Daniel junior is a shipyard labourer in Barrow. He and his remarried mother are visitors at the home Abraham Dent, hotel manager where sister Ethel is living as a barmaid.

In 1911 Daniel junior is living in Gardner Road Morecambe (West End) with his new wife and baby daughter. He is a ship's steward and appears to have worked on Midland Railway steamers. In 1939 He is a market and hackney carriage inspector.

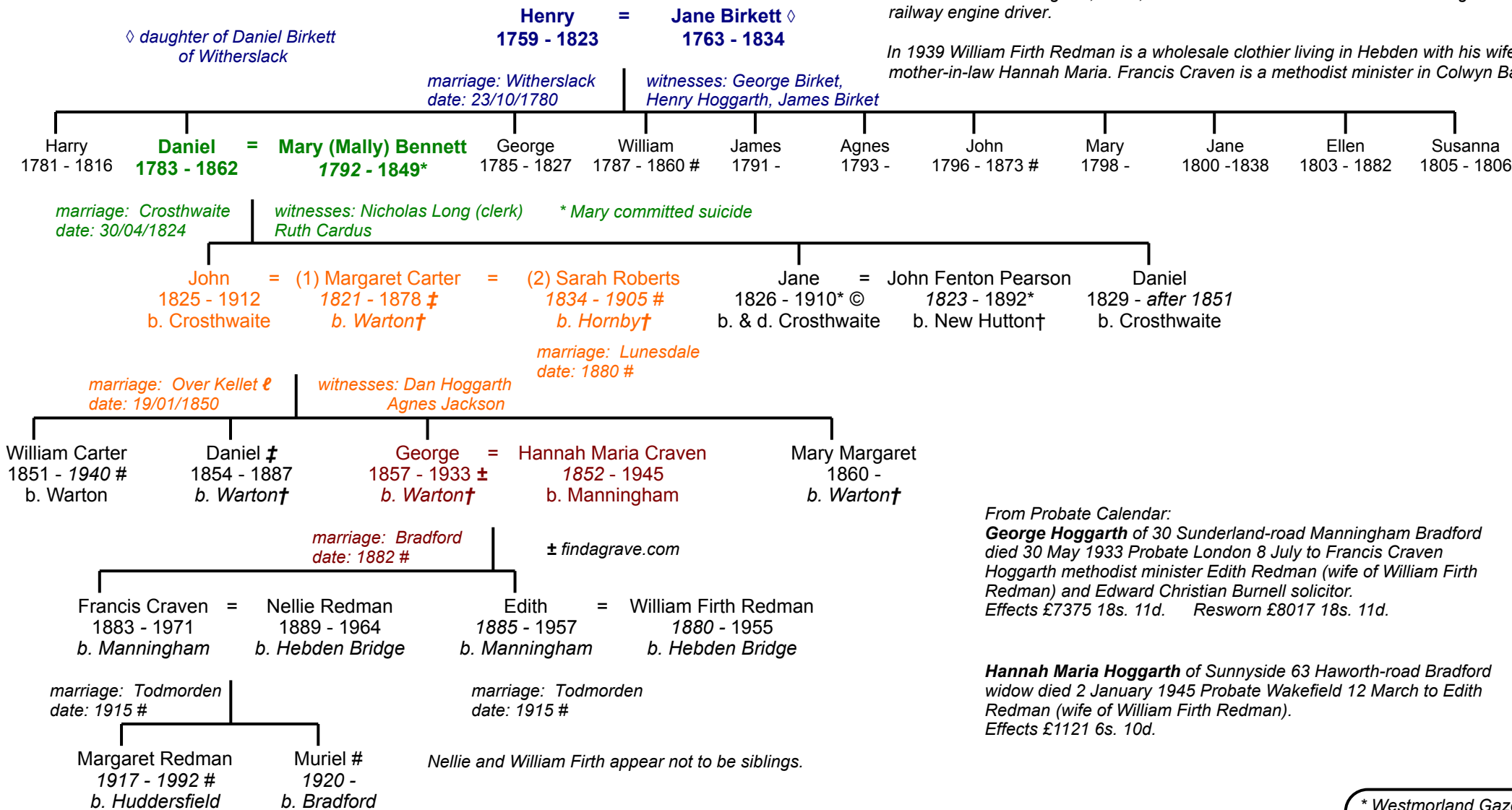

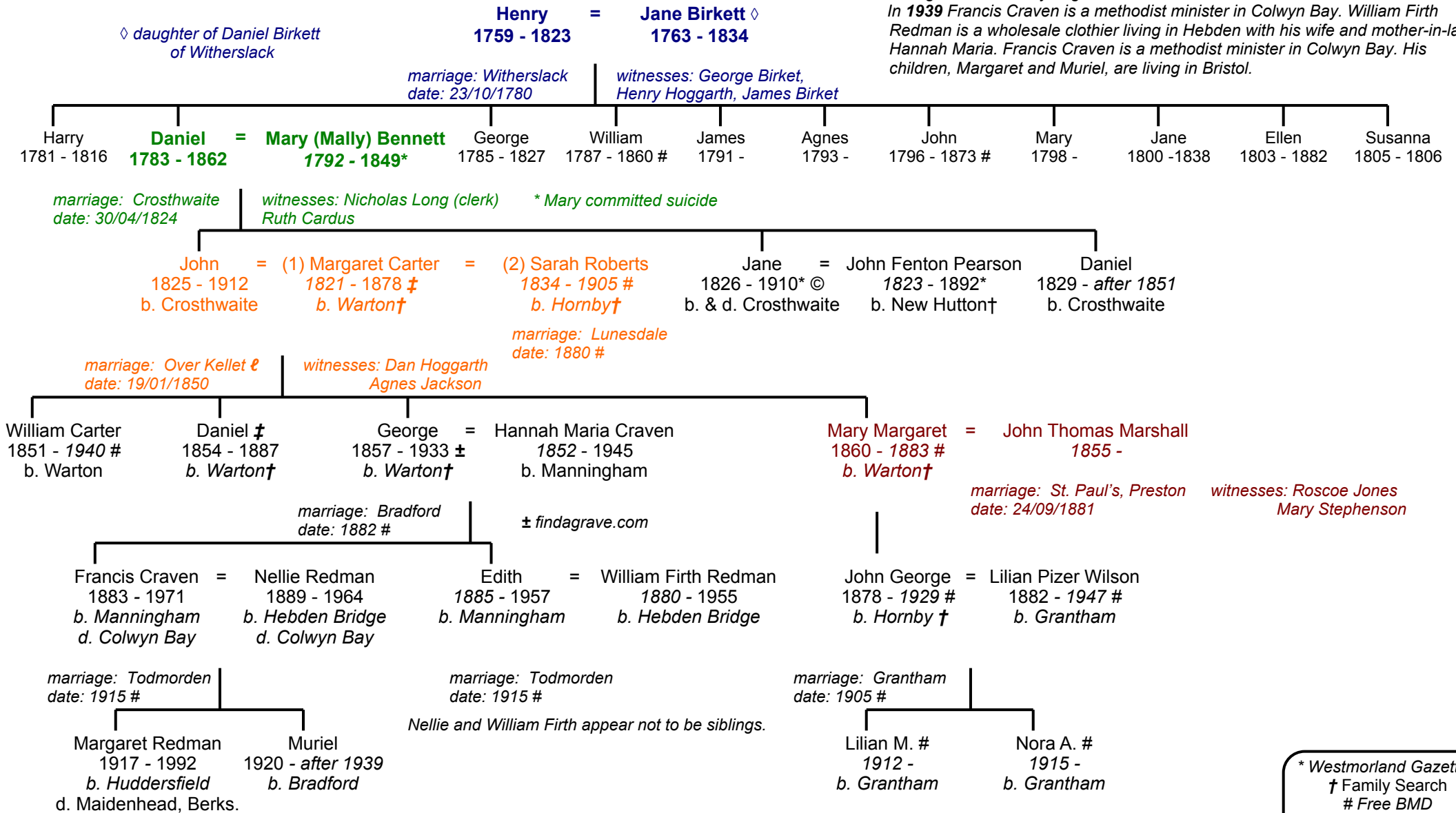
